1.0 Purpose

To outline the Fort Saskatchewan Minor Sport Association's (FSMSA) rules and regulations regarding the use of electronic recording devices in the locker and or change rooms accessed by all representatives of the FSMSA.

2.0 Scope

This policy applies to all of the Minor Sport programs under the umbrella of the FSMSA, currently including baseball, fastball, gymnastics, hockey, judo, lacrosse, ringette, soccer, and any other Minor Sports that may join the FSMSA. It applies to all members, officials, parents, players, team officials, paid employees, volunteers, and executive board members. It applies to locker and or change rooms that are located on premises leased by any FSMSA sport, or on property that a team or individual is visiting as a representative of the FSMSA.

3.0 Terms

Electronic Recording Devices – Any electronic device or portions of a device that is capable of taking still pictures, sound recordings, or video recordings.

4.0 Policy

- 4.1 All players, parents, and FSMSA Minor Sports' Representatives are expected to follow the Locker and or Change Room Policy (#4218) and the Social Media Policy (#8000) in regards to the use of electronic recording devices. Use of an electronic recording device for the purpose of cyber bullying or abuse of any kind, will not be tolerated.
- 4.2 Recording functions of an electronic device are not permitted to be used for any reason inside the locker and or change room. Should an individual be required to use the recording function of an electronic device, the person using it must leave the locker and or change room prior.
- 4.3 Music playback functions of an electronic device may be utilized in the locker and or change room provided that it is not disruptive to the facility. This type of usage is only permissible if the applicable provincial governing body and the league approve.
- 4.4 For instructional purposes, coaches will be allowed to use only the video playback functions of an electronic device in the locker and or change rooms, provided that the applicable provincial governing body and the league approve of said usage.

- 4.5 Any instance of an individual caught using the recording portions of an electronic device in a locker and or change room will be reviewed by the FSMSA Minor Sport's Executive Committee and may be punishable by suspension, expulsion, and or referring the matter to local policing authorities.
