Team registrations must be made using FYRA's RAMP registration platform. To register:

Tournament Logistics:

FUN2 games will have 4 teams on the ice at once, playing two half ice games in the one-hour slot.

U10 is full ice, jamboree format with no playoffs. There will be Tier 1 divisions at U12 and U14. Community level play continues to be offered at all divisions.

Game schedules will be communicated closer to the tournament date <u>but unlikely before March</u> <u> 8^{th} </u>.

FYRA will provide Timekeepers and Scorekeepers for all round robin/regular games and playoff games. For the U12, U14 and U16/19 divisions, the team listed as home on the score sheet will provide a shot clock operator during the Round Robin/Regular games. FYRA will supply the shot clock operator for all playoff games.
