# Travel Team: Player / Parent Behavior Agreement Policy

Gander Revolution Football Club (GRFC) is committed to providing a safe and inclusive environment for all players and program participants. GRFC's Right to Play policy encompasses the rights afforded to all players participating in Travel Teams. This is supported by the Friendly Fan, Anti Bullying, Fair Play Codes Of Conduct. GRFC's Travel Policy clarifies expectations of parents/guardians with regard to travel and accommodation.

### Commitment

Upon registration for Travel Team TRYOUTS, Travel Team Players and Parents agree to the following conditions:

- Players will make every attempt to attend all team functions (games, practices, and events). Parents will make every attempt to communicate non attendance ahead of time.
- @ U11 and U13, players will train together, but will be streamed for festivals/tournaments/matches based on extended training performance and ability levels. Therefore, it may be possible for players to move between teams, however this will be decided by coaches and communicated to parents as soon as possible. In such a short season, movement between teams is not expected to happen much.
- Players are required to attend 50% of practices to be invited to attend festivals/tournaments/matches. All players, irrespective of age group, are required to attend at least 50% of the season tournaments.
- Any player who relinquishes their commitment to a team for unreasonable circumstances (eg. doesn't agree with team placement, conflicts with other players/team members, etc.) may not be considered for a travel team the following season.
- Players of Travel Teams are required to participate in their respective NLSA Provincial Tournament.

### **Uniforms & Equipment**

Upon being assigned a position in a Travel Team, players will be provided with jerseys and socks.

- Players will be provided team jerseys. Team Jerseys are the property of GRFC, and players will be responsible for damages / loss while in the players possession.
- Players/parents will be responsible to return team jerseys back to GRFC at the end of the season. Failure to return GRFC jerseys will result in a fee charged to the parent.
- Players are required to wear GRFC socks, so they match the jerseys.
- Team jerseys are to be worn only at approved team games and functions.
- Players must wear all equipment as specified and required by NLSA and Soccer Canada while at training and during games, on the field or on the bench.

### **Cooling off period:**

GRFC requires all members to respect the 24-hour cooling off period.

Parents/guardians shall not approach coaches immediately after a team selection, game or practice to discuss events from tryouts, a game or practice. Once the 24 hours has passed, communication may be brought to a team manager or divisional director. The team manager is always the first line of communication, and they will bring all questions and concerns to the coaching staff or Technical Director

Under no circumstances shall a parent or guardian approach the bench, official's room or players dressing room or use social media during or immediately after a game or practice to air grievances. Such occurrences will be documented and brought to the GRFC executive for discussion and appropriate discipline implemented when necessary.
