Notes to Financial Statements

Year Ended August 31, 2023

1. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the statement of financial position of Greater Edmonton Lacrosse Council as at August 31, 2023, and the statements of revenues and expenditures and changes in net assets for the year then ended is on the historical cost basis and reflects cash transactions with the addition of:

- · accounts receivable
- prepaid expenses on advanced payments for goods and services to be received in the future
- property and equipment recorded at historical cost and amortized on a declining balance method
- · accounts payable and accrued liabilities

2. PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Greater Edmonton Lacrosse Council is a not-for-profit organization that promotes amateur lacrosse at all levels. The Greater Edmonton Lacrosse Council was incorporated January 29, 1986, is governed under the *Societies Act* of Alberta and is exempt under section 149 of the *Income Tax Act*.
