



PERMISSION TO TRYOUT / RELEASE

PURPOSE

SGHA follows OWHHA regulations governing player movement, including Permission to Tryout (PTT) and Player Releases.

GENERAL

PTT and Player Release requests are separate processes and are managed differently by SGHA.

A Permission to Tryout or Release will not be issued to any player who has not fulfilled their financial obligations to SGHA or who has not returned all equipment and jerseys.

PERMISSION TO TRYOUT

Eligibility

- SGHA will not issue a Permission to Tryout for competitive tryouts with another OWHHA team where SGHA offers a team at that level for the upcoming season.
- Players wishing to try out at a level offered by SGHA must apply for a release.

Request Process

- All PTT requests must be submitted using the [SGHA online request form](#).
- Requests must be complete at the time of submission. Incomplete requests may result in delays.
- Once approved, the completed PTT will be issued to the player and the requested association by email.

PLAYER RELEASE

Eligibility

- A Release may be granted to a player wishing to try out or play for another OWHHA association at a level offered by SGHA, in accordance with OWHHA regulations.
- Players granted a Release are not eligible to return to SGHA during that season.

Request Process

- Release requests must be submitted in writing to the SGHA Registrar.
- Requests must include the following information:
 - Player's full name and date of birth
 - Current SGHA team and division
 - Parent/guardian name(s) and contact information
 - Reason for the request (for administrative purposes)
 - Intended association (if applicable)



- Requests must be complete at the time of submission. Incomplete requests may result in delays.
- Once approved, the release will be processed through the RAMP system and confirmation will be issued.
