

Game jerseys MUST not be worn to practices!

Jersey Care

- Jerseys must be kept in garment bags, not in hockey gear bags
- Home Games White Jerseys, white socks
- Away Games Blue Jerseys, blue socks
- Jerseys and socks must be laundered regularly and kept in good condition. If damaged game socks must be replaced at the player's expense (this is OWHA policy for those teams who go to provincials)
- Jerseys will be collected by team staff and returned to the equipment manager at the end of each season with name bars/sponsor bars removed
- Game socks will be distributed each season and are included in registration fees

Name Bars

- Last names only on name bars no nick names
- Name bars added before first league game
- If more than one player with same last name add initial i.e. "R.Rocket"
- Do not use iron on material or glue for name bars or captain (C) or assistant (A) letters
- Name bars removed before returning jerseys to the Association

House Reversible Jerseys - Name Bars

- White name bar with navy letters on white side of jersey; Navy bar with white letters on navy side of jersey
- Name Bars should be sewn along the seam at the top of the jersey
- SPONSOR BARS are **NOT** to be used on these jerseys

Competitive Jerseys - Name Bars

- Both name bars are the same colour and should be sewn to the bottom of the jersey between the stripes.
- SPONSOR BARS once approved by <u>vp@ggha.ca</u> can be added to the top of the jersey.

Ordering Name Bars and Sponsor Bars

Team managers should collect the name bar order for the entire team and submit to <u>rocketsshop@ggha.ca</u>.

House teams are encouraged to use banners, flags etc in lieu of sponsor bars because of the house jersey design.

Jersey Return

All jerseys are to be collected by the team and returned to the SGHA equipment manager no later than April 15th or after the team's last tournament Name bars and sponsor bars should be removed and the jerseys / garment bags should be cleaned before being returned to the association.

Competitive Equipment

Competitive jerseys will be distributed in a SGHA garment bag. Jerseys must be stored and transported in this bag during the season.

Each competitive player is required to provide a postdated cheque to their team treasurer to cover the cost of replacing lost or damaged jerseys and/or garment bag. This payment must be received before the jersey kit is distributed to the player.

Cheques are to be collected by teams, submitted upon receipt of the competitive kit, and given to the Association Treasurer.

For items that are damaged or lost, the deposit cheque will be cashed and used to purchase those items. Any amount remaining will be refunded by SGHA to the player.
