



REGISTRATION POLICY

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This policy identifies the standards and process for SGHA registration.

IMPORT POLICY

The SGHA does not have an import policy.

Everyone is welcome to register and participate providing they are in good standing with the SGHA.

GENERAL

All players must register for all SGHA programs using the SGHA RAMP registration system.

- Players who have not fulfilled their financial obligations to the SGHA or who have not returned all SGHA equipment and jerseys will not be allowed to register for the ensuing season or be given a Release or Permission to Tryout (PTT) to play with another association until all obligations have been met.
- The SGHA reserves the right to cancel any program or division due to insufficient registration.
- All players must register in their age-appropriate division. Players may be considered to play in an older division on a case-by-case basis.
- An SGHA registered player may register as a player on only one SGHA team.
- Players can be added to an OWHA roster up until December 31. Players must play a minimum of five games with the team to be able to participate in Playoffs and Playdowns.

REGISTRATION FEES

All SGHA players registering for the season may choose to pay their registration fees by installments with all fees being paid by December 31 of that season.

Players may be removed from OWHA team rosters if their financial obligations are not met by that date.

GOALIES

Players who indicate "Goalie" on their registration must be prepared to play in goal on a full-time basis.

House League goalies may play half-time but the respective Evaluation Committee must be made aware before sortouts.

The Board will vet all goalies.
