

Grande Prairie Lacrosse Association Policies and Procedures

Amended November 2019

The name of the Society is “Grande Prairie Lacrosse Association”

This document constitutes the general policies and procedures of Grande Prairie Lacrosse Association. These policies and procedures regulate the transaction of business and affairs of the Association.

1. Preamble

The policies and procedures of the Grande Prairie Lacrosse Association hereafter known as GPLA are subject to terms and conditions imposed by the Greater Edmonton Lacrosse Association (“GELC”), the Alberta Lacrosse Association (“ALA”), the Canadian Lacrosse Association (“CLA”), and the Rocky Mountain Lacrosse League (“RMLL”). Where a conflict arises between these Bylaws and the Bylaws of GELC, ALA, CLA or RMLL, the policies and procedures of GELC, ALA, CLA or RMLL, will govern.

2. Multiple Teams

In the case when there are two teams registered at any one level of play those teams shall be parity. Participating players will be evaluated based on preset criteria by no less than 3 coaches, none of which will be the coaches of the teams. The players will then be split evenly based on those evaluations.

3. In the case where there are two teams in one division playing at two levels all players will have the opportunity to try out for and be evaluated for the team of their choice. Evaluations will be completed by no less than 3 coaches one of which will be the coach of the team they are trying out for and the coach of the higher level team will pick their team first .

4. Team logo

No team, player, parent or member will affix the logo of the GPLA to any clothing or product with out prior permission from the executive of the GPLA.

5. Team Clothing

No team, player, parent or member will purchase or order any clothing representing the GPLA from any supplier other than that which is identified as the official clothing supplier of the GPLA.

6. All coaches, assistant coaches and bench personal will meet all criteria for coaching requirements as outlined by the ALA, CLA and the GELC and no personnel who do not meet those criteria will be permitted on the bench during any game play.
