To set up the COVID waiver TeamLinkt: All of the parents will get a notification the morning of the event and will have to click "Agree". I can then go in and see who has completed and not completed the waiver.

The waiver that I am using reads as follows (I incorporated our questionnaire with some of their wording):

If you answer YES to any of the questions below, you CANNOT agree to this waiver.

Have you experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 48 hours:

- fever or chills
- cough
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- feeling unwell or fatigued
- muscle or body aches
- headache
- new loss of taste or smell
- sore throat
- nasal congestion or runny nose
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- conjunctivitis (pink eye)

Within the past 14 days, have you and anyone in your household travelled outside of Canada?

Within the past 14 days, have you, or anyone in your household, been in close physical contact (6 feet or closer for at least 15 minutes) with a person who is known to have laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 or with anyone who has any symptoms consistent with COVID-19?

Are you isolating or quarantining because you may have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 or are worried that you may be sick with COVID-19?

Are you currently waiting on the results of a COVID-19 test?

I declare that myself or my child has not answered YES to any of the above questions.

****If you answer yes to any of the above questions, then you must inform the team manager that your player will not be attending and then follow the recommended AHS protocols before your player may participate again.**

You will need to compile a weekly attendance record and keep for 14 days – attached.

COVID

Once cohorts/teams are formed in any age group after the evaluation process and there are 2 COVID Liaison volunteers named per Cohort Group and those Liaisons have the required training through GPMHA office, there will be spectators permitted in the viewing areas for all ice times. The number of spectators will be limited to the permitted number of spectators that each facility allows. It will be up to the COVID Liaisons to monitor this for each group. It is recommended (not mandatory) that spectators wear a mask while in the arena.

*** Note any spectators found breaking the social distance policy of the facility will be asked to leave the facility immediately. ***
