3) Convenors Reports:

U12P Convenor Report

- All games are played and up to date.
- Everyone is submitting scores except for one game on November 16th

- Request made to have a tiered system in the East because scores are showing 4 strong teams vs. weaker teams with large score differences.
- When the schedule was made, an attempt was made to match the team ability with #1 teams playing #1, #2 playing #2 and #3 and #3 play #3 teams. It appears some of the #2 need to be dropped to play
- Does any of the Western teams want to have cross play? Convenor from GLRL and Convenor from Western Region will reach out to the coaches to see if its possible to have the top teams from GLRL play top teams from Western
 - o Biggest impact is the effect on the already scheduled games
- The Richmond Hill, Mississauga, Ajax and Burlington are the top 4 teams in GLRL looking for more competition
- Suggestion is to keep league play as is and provide contact information so they can schedule their own exhibition games.
- Concern is Ajax is 4-0 but only played 3rd tiered teams so may look stronger than they are.
- Concern raised from Markham that one team did not let up when they were winning by large margins.
 - Should sanctions be applied? We should first try talking to the association and the coach.
 - Should we be having ½ year schedule then reseeding and reshuffle?
 Could consider for next year but not this year.
 - There is a push for all organizations to have U12p team as a minimal to open up competition level in the organizations because if you don't start with U12p then its hard to enter the level later on.

 - G&T guidance confirmed the request for two team players is past the deadline, but can be reviewed with the entire committee for approval
- Some issues with games being curfewed

U19AA Convenor Report

- Jim File present

- Very positive feedback on the four 11 periods and no curfew issues
- Need to remind teams that they can substitute 12 players as a max.
- Some team formation issues with southern region as well.

4) GLRL Logo Contest – update

- Logo was selected
- Winner Syndey Richardson from Burlington
- Logo is now visible on the website and starting to be used on documents
- Positive feedback being received, and the process followed to pick the logo was great

5) Treasurer's Report - Tom Anderson

- Not much to report
- Current balance \$8100 in chequing, \$9500 in bond fees held in trust
- Two cheques that have not been cashed follow-up occurring
 - Overpayment of GLRL fees by Waterloo
 - Cheque to David Woolcott to be cashed
- All associations paid except for 1 association still outstanding team fees. Follow-up is in process.

6) Feedback regarding new U16AA & U19AA Game Format

- General feedback is positive, and people are enjoying the new format
- Phil has solicited feedback from coaches and refs, and all feedback was positive
- One comment made about coaches forgetting to use their time-out in the first ½ and hoping to use two time-outs in the second ½ of the game. This is a learning curve.
- Andrea received feedback from officials that they would like an opportunity to flood between the 2-3 period. This would depend on each facility and Zamboni availability
- Ringette Ontario has asked us to provide feedback on the format at mid-season. This will be added as an agenda item to focus on at the next meeting.
- Concerned with playing this format in league play and how it affected teams in the tournament play. No data at this time. Will need to investigate further.

7) GLRL Game Sheets

- What should associations be doing with the game sheets?
- In Western region, game sheets are collected by the associations and given to G&T to keep on file for reference and review.

- Southern region does not collect game sheets. The home association is to keep the game sheets and G&T can reach out to the association if needed.
- Central region does not collect game sheets. The home association is to keep the game sheets and G&T can reach out to the association if needed.
- Best practice at this time is for each region to continue doing what works for them.

8) GLRL Major Penalty Reporting

- Major penalties must be sent to the G&T for the region
- Western region uses an online reporting system
- Southern region has an online form to submit on Southern region website
- Central region is submitting on the Central region website.
- This may be an issue that information has not been communicated back to the coaches of the teams.
- Suggest Convenors send a major penalty report to coaches with summary of meeting results.
- Opportunity to streamline the process for all regions and reduce redundancies in the future

9) U12P Tryout Process for 2020/21 Season

- Need to discuss the sports development request/policy not to be able to make the team in the spring
- GLRL would like to know the impact of this policy and how it's affecting our associations (i.e. losing players, facility issues,)
- Mississauga families are not happy with the policy and families feel marginalized. Feel like a lot of associations are hiding that they are making teams in Spring. Parents aren't happy and coaches aren't happy.
- Dorchester has issues around the effect on regional teams and the team formation. Goalies have been lost
 to hockey. Not fair play because the people who can afford the summer activities such as ringette camps
 and gives other kids an advantage.
- Concerns with small associations not having ice and all-year facilities to support this structure. Logistics
 don't work for small associations with ice not being available as ice is taken out during the summer. Coaches
 not stepping up for Regional because waiting to make provincial. Athletes are stressed and partaking in
 ringette activities all summer to try and make the Fall tryout.
- Concerns from Whitby with the haves and have nots. Putting emotional strain on players with some being picked in the Spring and others having to wait until the Fall.
- London has concerns with the layover until the Fall causing stress on players and affecting the regional team's formation.
- Reason for the spring tryout is direction from sports development for athletes to be more well balanced trying different sports but this is not happening. Also may be because of funding from sports development
- No positive feedback on this change from associations.

12) G + T Report

- Andrea reporting
- Ensure any TRF adjustments are being submitted at least a week in advance to ensure they are reviewed as a bit more time is needed to coordinate between all the regions.
- Now that a few tournaments have gone by, G&T is looking for like players to play with like teams.
- Found that goalie changes are being left to the last minute.
- Encourage coaches to reach out to G&T with questions about substitutions, suspensions, etc.

14) New Business

Game curfews

- Some examples of games being curfewed at U14 and U19 ages
- Try to avoid curfews as best we can
- Out of respect for the visiting team, we ask that the home team tell the coach and officials know that there may be a potential for this to be curfewed.
- Need to communicate better and early.
- Example, Forest was in Oshawa and was curfewed. Coaches were not made aware of it and there was ice available. Need to consider the distance that was travelled to play some of these games.
- O Guelph was also curfewed at Oshawa tournament with 7 min left and was removed for a hockey tournament. Went to grievance and it was rejected. Oshawa didn't have a lot of control. Oshawa reps confirmed that the City will not be give any leeway on extra time on ice. Oshawa is looking at ways to get more time.
- U16A game situation Video Review
 - There was an incident on the ice where ref called a minor penalty
 - The Elora-Fergus team sent in video to western region G&T. The perception is that the video was reviewed by G&T and G&T suggested that it should be a major penalty instead of a minor penalty as this was in last 4 minutes of the game.
 - The incident was intent to injury with serious concussion injury.
 - This video was submitted at a more administrative issue and not at the time of the game.
 - o Decided that this needs to be submitted to Officiating not G&T.
 - o **Request:** what is the policy/process for submitting video to review officiating decisions?
