notifications.



# 5) GLRL Financial Report – Tom Anderson

- Transactions this month included:
  - Return Newmarket ringette bond fee \$500
  - \$100 Team Fee for Markham U19AA collected
  - Markham U19AA team folding was fined \$500, and this was used for associations payments reimbursed ice costs to Ajax (\$400 for 2 ice times) and Richmond Hill (\$200 for 1 ice time).
  - \$792.29 expenses still to reconcile
- Bank Balances listed below. The savings account includes \$11,000 of association bond payments held in trust.
- \$400 outstanding in GLRL team fese which has been arranged with Tom due to a lost cheque

 Markham is withdrawing the U12A team for the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the season and moving the team down to U12B

- Western region is pretty happy with the way the current division is set up as viewed by Shelley Handley as Western Region Provincial Chair
- Burlington is happy with where they are in their division
- Forest is happy with current status and doesn't believe the stats show how close the games really are
- Etobicoke is bored and wants more of a challenge. Travelling to forest would be a long day.
  - Would the team be willing to travel to East/West for a day of games? Barrie and Etobicoke would be willing to look at this.
  - Burlington is willing to be middle ground Ice for exhibition games for western and southern/central to meet. Jenn has spoken with the Burlington Ice Scheduler.
- Barrie U12A is willing to do travelling to play Western teams
- Jim File suggested picking 2 top teams from west and east do some cross over and don't play the bottom teams in same division. Divisions would stay the same otherwise. Then the 2 bottom teams could have crossover play as well if needed.
- Whitby is a young team and building. It is ok to stay in the same division.
- Mississauga is polling the parents on how they feel about the season as their only wins were against Markham who are withdrawing.
- Waterloo won gold in London tournament and are willing to play tougher teams if it helps to book double headers and book central ice.
- Oshawa is also willing to travel to get to play more challenging teams.
- Richmond Hill has rotating goalies, so scores are distorted as some games have big wins and some have big losses.

Action Item: Associations to see if they have ice that can be used to schedule cross over games and let Phil Singeris & Jim File know via email.

# Second Half Ice Submission

- Need all Ice by December 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Need 8-10 ice times from each association between January 7<sup>th</sup> March 26th
- All games in first half must be played out
- Will work with scheduler and regional reps about cross over play

## Regional Year-End Championships

- Southern Championship March 31 April 2 in Oshawa
- Western Championship April 14-16 in Kitchener
- GLRL doesn't have anything to do with planning of regional but last year GLRL made recommendation of which teams would go to which championships based on league play
- Both regions have enough ice to accommodate teams, but they need to know how many teams are going to each championship to plan
- Decisions would be based on dates and who is willing to travel
- Teams will not be forced to play outside their region
- Ringette Ontario is forcing regional play at U12A level, but some teams are clearly not getting meaningful play
- Northern teams are not coming to Southern Championships this year as they did last year
- Western and Southern could have flexibility to get more ice if request to host all U12A teams in one area if enough notice is given.
- It could be possible to split the teams in divisions and send 1 division to Southern event and 1 division to Western event, but the organizers need to know the # of teams in the division to secure ice times. Currently total of 14 teams in U12A division.

- Both Southern and Western have 4 game guarantees for U12A.
- Chris Sharpe believes that optics for this event would be better to send 7 teams to Southern and 7 teams to Western event.
- GLRL will only be making a recommendation on what could be done based on GLRL standings and the Chairpersons of the regional events will make the final decisions.

Action Item: Associations need to ask their U12A teams which championships they are willing to attend

- Update on U14 Program for Next Season
  - U14AA will continue for next year but most likely not after that
  - Removing U14AA is a Ringette Canada initiative not Ringette Ontario and is already being removed in Quebec

# • Movement of A team to AA requested to be added by Brian Kettles

- Some concerns around U19 level around moving teams around
- Nancy from Competitions was instructed that they cannot move teams between A and AA due to the impact on league play and tournaments.
- Biggest concern around Dorchester U19A Lindsay team being 8 wins and 0 losses and concerns around Dorchester having 2 teams in the same division and one not moved to AA.
  - Associations do not understand why Dorchester and London didn't have a U19AA.
  - The question is "how did Western region allow this?" There needs to be some lessons learned from how this decision came to be.
  - The other concern is that the 2 Dorchester U19A teams do not play each other which was a GLRL suggestion not knowing it would create conflict.
- GLRL needs to have a meeting around team formation and how regions make decisions in a later January meeting to provide recommendations on how this can be done better.
