Every player starts somewhere, and we welcome all skill levels! While skating experience is helpful, it's not required. Our dedicated coaches and volunteers will help new players develop their skills in a fun and supportive environment.

House League vs. Rep Hockey

House League

- Open to all female players no tryouts required.
- Teams have 15 skaters + 2 goalies (waitlists may apply if full).
- Competes in the Greater Hamilton Girls Hockey League (GHGHL) (www.ghghl.ca).
- Season includes **14-20 games + playoffs**, culminating in the **Super Sunday Championship** in March.
- Average 1 game & 1 practice per week.
- Optional tournament participation (additional cost).

Players are encouraged to participate in fundraising for the organization.

Rep Hockey

- Players **must** attend tryouts and be selected by the coach.
- Competes in the OWHA Southern League (22-game season + playoffs).
- Additional **OWHA Playdowns** determine qualification for Provincial Championships.
- Extra fees apply for additional ice time, tournaments, development, and sponsorships.
- Expected time commitment: 3-5 times per week, depending on age and team.
