

# **SOCCER TECHNICAL LEAD – Female Pathway**

## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

### **Role Overview**

The Female Pathway Lead is responsible for the design, delivery, and ongoing development of the girls' soccer pathway at Halifax Dunbrack Soccer Club. This includes oversight of all female teams within the club from Skill Centre and above, providing leadership across the female program, and collaborating with technical staff across the club.

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## **TECHNICAL LEADERSHIP**

- Provide technical leadership, mentorship, and ongoing support to coaches within the female program
  - Collaborate with the Pre-Performance Director to build and align the female pathway across all teams in the club
  - Design and deliver age-appropriate training sessions across all development levels (Skill Centre, AA, A, and B)
  - Utilize Sport Session Planner to create sessions and support coaches with planning and delivery
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## **COACH MANAGEMENT AND SUPPORT**

- Recruit and mentor female coaches
  - Provide ongoing support to coaches of female teams
  - Deliver regular coach education sessions to enhance knowledge and development within the female program
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## **PLAYER DEVELOPMENT**

- Organize and oversee player evaluations across all levels of play
  - Support team coaches in creating and implementing individualized player development plans
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## **OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Lead and coach at a female-specific summer camp (one week duration)

- Coordinate and deliver technical aspects of female training sessions across the program
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## **REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS**

- Minimum Canada Soccer C Licence (or equivalent)
  - Experience in player development and program leadership, preferably within youth or female soccer
  - Strong understanding of Long-Term Player Development (LTPD) principles
  - Strong communication, organizational, and leadership skills
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## **EXPECTED WORKLOAD**

- Approximately 12 hours per week
