- ** denotes suspension length is subject AMBHA review
- Officials include on and off floor Officials, or anyone attending the game solely on behalf of GCBHL.
- These are minimum suspensions. Additional suspensions may be imposed wherever conditions or circumstances warrant.
- Multiple suspensions in a single season may involve a Discipline Committee review which may lead to additional games. Previous years' history may also be considered.
- All suspensions must be served in regular season, playoffs and Provincials/Westerns games. Exhibition, All-Star games, etc. will not count as games served.
- It is the responsibility of each coach to ensure their players sit out their appropriate suspensions. When in doubt as to the relevant suspension, contact the association office. If unable to contact the league office, sit player(s) in question out until clarification can be obtained. These suspensions are in addition to game incurred.
- Coaches who allow suspended players to play will may be suspended up to a year or for lifetime, subject to review by AMBHA / CBHA.
