- 1. I will be reasonable in scheduling games and practices, remembering that young athletes have other interests and obligations.
- 2. I will teach my athletes to play fairly and to respect the rules, officials, opponents and teammates.
- 3. I will ensure that all athletes get equal instruction, discipline, support and playing time. The just "average players" need and deserve equality.
- 4. I will not ridicule or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I will be generous with praise and set a good example. I will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.
- 5. I will remember that children need a coach they can respect.
- 6. I will develop team respect for the ability of opponents, as well as for the judgment of officials and opposing coaches.
- 7. I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athlete's ages and abilities.
- 8. I recognize that as coach, I am a powerful role model for my players and I must set a good example.
- 9. I will make a personal commitment to keep myself informed on sound coaching principles of growth and development of children.
