



Transfer Player Process

When considering allowing a A/AA player to transfer into Halifax City Soccer Club the following will be considered:

1. What is the reason for the individual wanting to transfer clubs?
2. Does the player align with the Club's values and Guiding Principles?
3. Will the club environment benefit the player? Will the player benefit the club environment?
4. Are we displacing any current HCSC members by allowing a transfer player to register?

If all criteria above are met the following process will commence:

Transfer players will have to go through the trial process regardless of the level they previously played at their previous club. For simplicity and transparency our transfer acceptance process is as followed:

- 1. Halifax City Players who are registered and recommended for A/AA*
- 2. Returning Halifax City players (They didn't play winter for example) where the A/AA environment is most appropriate without displacing any players from the priority chain above.*
- 3. Transfer players where the environment is most appropriate without displacing any players from the priority chain points 1 and 2*
