



COACH / STAFF REGISTRATION

If you are going on the ice this season you will need to register in RAMP for insurance purposes. This includes **Coaches, Trainers, Safety, Junior Coaches AND On-Ice Volunteers**. Team Managers and Board Members are also required to register through RAMP.

What you need to register:

ALL Coaches, Trainers, Safety, Junior Coaches over the age of 18 and On-Ice Helpers are required to take their **Respect in Sport Activity Leader Certificate** which can be obtained from the following website: <https://ha.respectgroupinc.com/>

- You must complete the course and have the RIS Activity Leader certificate number in order to complete the Coach/Staff Registration. This course must be renewed every 4 years.

Required but not needed to complete RAMP Registration:

These items are required by all team officials including but not necessarily limited to coaches, trainers, managers, board members and any others who may work directly with the players.

- **Criminal Record Check (CRC) or Vulnerable Sector Checks (VSC)** must be completed in order to coach. CRC/VSC is valid for 3 years. Authorization letters are only needed for Criminal Record Checks at our RCMP detachment and are available from Lindsay Descheneau at 780-817-8986.
- **Intervention Check (Child Welfare Check)** must be completed each year in order to coach. A Child Welfare Check does not need an authorization letter and can be done at FCSS - downstairs at the town office. Please allow ample time for these checks to be completed as the processing time has increased since last season.

These MUST be completed and uploaded into your RAMP profile by October 15th.

Here are the steps to register on RAMP:

1. Login to your Ramp family account.

2. Select Coach/Staff registration
3. Choose a family member (this is you, not your child – add yourself as a member if you are not already listed). Make sure address & contact information is correct.
4. Enter a valid Respect in Sport Coach Certificate number.
5. Choose preferred division, Select a role (Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager). Continue.

6. CRC/VSC / Intervention Check: You can continue past this step at this time if you do not have the completed check done at time of registration, **however, these MUST be completed AND uploaded into your RAMP profile by October 30.** Failure to do so will result in your inability to be rostered and therefore you will no longer be able to coach. If you have a newly completed CRC, please enter the completed date and upload a copy of the form. If you have a valid CRC, please enter the date completed. No need to upload the picture. Registrar has copies on file. Intervention Check-please enter completion date and upload.
7. Certifications: Please check off certifications you hold and dates courses were completed.
8. Indicate if you are interested in coaching any additional divisions
9. Confirm details and edit information if necessary. Submit registration.

NEW IN 2021-22:

To register for clinics and view qualifications, coaches need to create an HCR 3.0 account. eHockey no longer exists so if you have completed courses in the past they will need to be linked to your new HCR 3.0 account.

HCR 3.0 is also where you will go to sign up for required online courses and clinics.

Please see attached Hockey Alberta's Coaching Requirements table on the following page.

Coach 1 is required to coach U7 and U9, as well as the online Safety Course. You'll note in the table for U7 and U9 Hockey AB states that 1 coach per 10 players MUST have the Coach 1 and Safety but HMHA is recommending it for all coaches. This way if someone is away, we are still meeting the requirements.

Coach 2 and Checking Courses are required for U11 and above. You'll also see below the Hockey Alberta Coaching requirements.

Prior to attending the in-person Coaching Clinic, coaches must complete the HU-Online Coach 1/Coach 2 course.

If you are a second year U9 coach and plan to coach again in U11 you are welcome to take the Coach 2 and Checking Course this year if you already have Coach 1. Just as an FYI, if you have Coach 2 but not Coach 1, you still require Coach 1 to coach U7 and U9 Levels as it covers information not included in the Coach 2 course.

Hinton Minor hockey will reimburse you for taking any of the required courses. Please contact treasurer@hintonminorhockey.com for details.

Summary of what you'll need to ensure you have to Coach:

- Registered as a Coach in your RAMP profile
- Completed your Respect in Sport – Activity Leader
- Have a valid Criminal Record Check (good for 3 years)
- Have a valid Child Welfare Check (due every year)
- Uploaded the CRC & Intervention Check into your RAMP Profile
- Have Coaching Courses required for your division as per Hockey Alberta's Coaching Requirements OR Signed Up for Coaching Courses required

IMPORTANT INFORMATION	
Respect in Sport – Activity Leader	Must be completed prior to registration to a team (cannot be on ice without valid RIS). Must renew every 4 years.
November 15th	Deadline for coaches to have qualifications complete (except Respect in Sport – please see above). Team is ineligible to compete after this date if Coach requirements are not fulfilled.
Assistant Coaches	Highly recommended to obtain training of what is required for Head Coaches in applicable level
Development 1 & High Performance 1	Coaches must be " <i>trained</i> " by November 15 th of current season, by following seasons November 15 th must be " <i>certified</i> " to remain eligible. <i>Trained</i> = attended classroom session <i>Certified</i> = passed all post task evaluations
