Hockey League Update

Apparel

- Brit is working on getting some new sponsors for the season. She and Sarah will sit down to work on the website to sponsor logos.
- Possibly put off getting an apparel sponsor for this season as we are a little late. Brit will work on a sponsor/commitment for next season.
