Strathcona Minor Hockey is the Host for the 2020 Peewee AA Provincial Championships. If Strathcona is the EFHL Peewee AA Playoff Champion, the runner up team in the Championship Final will act as the host team. (Metro Team)

Peewee Tier 1: The EFHL League Playoff Champion will represent EFHL at Hockey Alberta Peewee Tier 1 Provincial Championships.

Peewee Tier 2: The EFHL League Playoff Champion will represent EFHL at Hockey Alberta Peewee Tier 2 Provincial Championships. The runner up in the final Playoff Championship game will be given the Hockey Alberta Wild Card berth in the Provincial Championship.

Peewee Tier 3: The EFHL League Playoff Champion will represent EFHL at Hockey Alberta Peewee Tier 3 Provincial Championships.

Peewee Tier 4: The EFHL League Playoff Champion will represent EFHL at Hockey Alberta Peewee Tier 4 Provincial Championships.

If the League Playoff Champion is a Metro Edmonton team, the host team will be the runner up of the Metro Bantam Tier 2 Playoff Championship game. If the League Playoff Champion is a Regional EFHL team, the host team will be the runner up from the League Playoff Championship game from the Metro Division.

Bantam Tier 3: The EFHL League Playoff Champion will represent EFHL at Hockey Alberta Bantam Tier 3 Provincial Championships. If the League Playoff Champion is a Metro Edmonton team, the host team will be the runner up of the Metro Bantam Tier 3 Playoff Championship game. If the League Playoff Champion is a Regional EFHL team, the host team will be the runner up from the League Playoff Championship game from the Metro Division.

Midget:

Midget Tier 1: The EFHL League Playoff Champion will represent EFHL at Hockey Alberta Midget Tier 1 Provincial Championships.

Midget Tier 2: The EFHL League Playoff Champion will represent EFHL at Hockey Alberta Midget Tier 2 Provincial Championships. The runner up in the final Championship game will be given the Hockey Alberta Wild Card berth in the Provincial Championship.
