Proposed Yearly League Awards - Hockey Regina

Awards will be handed out at the Volunteer Appreciation Night on Friday, March 27.

Community Involvement Award

This award will be sponsored by CNG Stone and presented to a Hockey Regina team who has demonstrated a strong desire to help others in their community. It is meant to encourage our players to give back and hopefully they will carry that consideration and awareness forward with them in life.

Eligibility and nomination details:

- submit a written nomination as well as a short video of the team assisting in the community
- community assistance must have taken place in the current hockey season
- any funds raised must not have been for team profit
- participation must have been by a team, this is not an individual award

Award details:

- a plaque will remain in the HRI office to be added to each year. The team name as well as the player's names will be added
- each player and the coaching staff will receive individual awards
- possibly a team event (depends on sponsorship amount)

The announcement will be made to the winning coach at the Volunteer Appreciation Night and then the coach and Scott Tresek can award the team at a team event ex: wind-up. The video of the winning team's community assistance will be played at the Volunteer Appreciation Night.

Volunteer of the Year Award sponsored by the Regina Hotel Association

This award will be presented annually to a volunteer who has made an outstanding contribution to Hockey Regina during the current season; coach (team official), manager (team administrator), board member, parent volunteer etc. This individual will have volunteered their time and have received no monetary consideration.

Eligibility and nomination details:

- submit the nomination form (which they will get from our website) and write a brief narrative describing the efforts and contributions of the nominee
- must have participated as an HRI volunteer in the current hockey season
- nominee must be 18 years of age or older
- previous award winners will not be eligible (going forward)

Award details:

- a plague will remain in the HRI office to be added to each year
- recipient will receive an award sponsored by the Regina Hotel Association

Volunteer Service Award

This award is meant to honour a person who has made an outstanding voluntary contribution to Hockey Regina (minor hockey in Regina) for a considerable period of time. Their contribution could have come in player/coach development, team administration, coaching, officials, facilitation/planning etc.

Eligibility and nomination details:

- submit the nomination form (which they will get from our website) and write a brief narrative describing the efforts and contributions of the nominee
- nominee must be 18 years of age or older
- previous award winners will not be eligible (going forward)

Award details:

- a plaque will remain in the HRI office to be added to each year
- recipient will receive an award from Hockey Regina

The 2019/20 season nominations will be open until March 10. The awards details and criteria will be posted this week. All entries and questions will be handled by Joanne. After the deadline an awards committee will review the nominations and select the winning recipients.
