Hockey Regina Board Briefing Note

Topic: Making Hockey Accessible through Volunteer Opportunities at HRI Bingo Opportunities

Situation:

Currently, the goal of Hockey Regina to provide the opportunity for each player's parents to participate in minimally one bingo per year. The bingo year is from **Dec 1 to Nov30**. Payment for bingos is based in the hours worked. Bingo vouchers will be \$70.00 for 6 hour bingos and \$45.00 for 4 hour bingos. Bingo vouchers can be used as part of the registration fee payment at the time of team registration.

Background:

An assessment of payment for volunteers at HRI bingos demonstrate that often time individuals volunteering at bingos with a 4 hour time frame are often staying closer to 5 hours at a rate of approximately \$9/hr and those at late night bingos often time make up to \$12/hr.

An environmental scan of other organizations including Ringette, Diving, Softball, Soccer, Church, Prairie Storm, Saskatoon Hockey and Rider game volunteering indicates that reimbursement for volunteer hours in these groups rates from \$11.45/hr up to \$26/hr with the mean reimbursement closer to \$13/hr. Over the past several years, HRI has netted between \$36K to \$111K annually on bingo as a fundraiser (2013 - \$105.98; 2014 - \$66,121; 2015 - \$111,199; 2016 - \$82,931; 2017 - \$74,188; 2018 - \$26,298). Typically, the profit margin is in the range of 30% of total revenue raised from the bingo.

The Bingo Hall requires workers to bet there:

- 10:30-until end of bingo (usually by 3:45 but could be later) 5 + hours (matinee)
- 5 pm 9:45 (end of bingo but can go longer) 5 hours (evening)

Information from a current bingo volunteer that still works bingos - 21 years ago worker bingo vouchers were \$75 at Rochdale Bingo. They went down to \$45 after they eliminated smoking in bingo halls. Around 2013/2014 Neil Hruska was on the board at the time and was also bingo coordinator had asked to increase vouchers. They were increased to \$50. Then went back down to \$45 shortly after. There were \$55 vouchers for evening bingos and were for those who came 15 minutes earlier to count bonanzas. This took a lot of managing as who was

Goalie Development Sessions Proposal

We are recommending that we use Rob Mountain. Rob will be responsible for the planning of the development sessions and will be on the ice to do the training. He will also be responsible for bringing out extra help as required.

Alternating sessions will focus on movement (not a lot of pucks) and then stations to work on game like situations and technique. Our intention is to have the goalies' coaches on the ice to help and train, allowing them to implement some of the items learned at these sessions in the goalies regular practices.

We will target U9 and U11 to start in November and December. The program may be expanded to U13 depending on the number of goalies that are utilizing the sessions.

Sessions will be held Nov 20/21, Nov 27/28 and Dec 18/19 from 6:45 to 7:45am.

Costs: Instruction is \$185/hr for every hour on the ice, which will include all necessary planning sessions. The sessions before Christmas will cost \$1110 + ice (estimated at \$250/hr * 6 = 1500) for a total of \$2610.

We plan on offering 10 session after Christmas which will have a cost of \$4350.

What we don't know is how popular this program will be, and as such, may see an increased cost in instructors.

Our base costs will be \$6960 and I would like to ask for another \$2000 as a contingency to pay for more instructors, should it be necessary.

Total ask is for \$9000.
