Criteria to use in picking teams (adopted in 2013/14)

U9

• (New for 2019) No Associates, Hockey Sask rule

U11

- (New for 2016) Limit admittance to Associates with a tiering process similar to Regina. IE, AA, A, etc. (Lumsden, Moose Jaw and Prairie Storm)
 - Limit the radius to 80KM.
 - o The only exception is Grand Coulee/Pense.

U13

- Limit admittance to Associates with a tiering process similar to Regina. IE, AA, A, etc. (Lumsden, Moose Jaw and Prairie Storm)
 - This will level the playing field at lower tiers
 - Limit the radius to 80KM.
 - The only exception is Grand Coulee/Pense

U15 + u18

- No changes to the current Associates.
 - Currently our U15 and U18 AA teams are traveling greater distance. EG.
 U15 travels province wide, U18 travels Southern Sask.
 - Most "star" rural players would be playing AAA or AA
 - o The A teams will be traveling less than the AA teams.
- No additional Associates to play in HRI.
 - Any Associates that are wishing to join will currently be playing in a league now. So they will have a place to play

Associate Review Committee

- Increase Associate fees from \$1,000/team to \$1,100/team. This will be the same as Saskatoon
- Update regulation that Associates mirror HRI team sizes in respective A and B divisions, under exceptional circumstances approved by the HRI Board of Directors
- Reiterate to only AP when missing a body, not to increase roster size.

Weyburn

- U15: A 1 team. Currently play in HRI
- Recommend to accept

Lumsden

- U11 Mixed: 1 team at A, B, C;
- U11 Female: 1-B, 1-C (will play in Female division if available)
- U13: 1 team at A, B, C (44 skaters, 5 goalies)
- U15: 1-A, 2-B (53 skaters, 5 goalies)
- U18: 1-A, 2-B (52 skaters, 4 goalies)
- Recommend for acceptance
- (limit the dual registered Female players playing in playoffs??)

Prairie Storm

- U11 Mixed: 2-A, 2-B, 3-C
- U11 Female: 1-B, 2-C (will play in Female division if available
- U13: A 2, B 2, C 2. Potentially a female team in B.
- U15: A 2, B 3
- U18: A 2, B 2. If lower numbers, then only 1 B team
- Stress that roster size similar to HRI, especially at U11
- Recommend for acceptance

Grand Coulee/Pense

- U11: B 1 team, (17 skaters), Maybe 2 teams depending on numbers
- U13: B-1 team (17 skaters). Look to move them to U13A. They have been in the U13B finals last 5 years, winning it 4 times
- Recommend to accept

<u>Melville</u>

- U15: A 1 team
- Currently form a provincial team, and a house team. House team plays in Major Hockey League.
- Provincial team played Exhibition and tournament games
- Ice time not an issue
- Recommend to decline. They have a league to play in if they so choose

Notre Dame

- U18A 1 team, maybe 2 depending on registration
- Recommend to accept

Cupar + Southey

- U18A 1 team Cupar. Currently play in HRI
- U13A + U15A combine with Southey. Currently Play in the East Minor Hockey League
- Recommend to accept U18A
- Do not accept U13A + U15A. They currently have a league to play in.

Moose Jaw

Yorkton + Moosomin

- Both wish to bring us a U15A team
- Their set-up is similar to Melville with respect to the formation and league they play in
- Recommend to decline both. They have a league to play in if they so choose
