Dear U11 Coaches and Parents:

Haines Junction Minor Hockey is excited to be hosting the **U11 Yukon Championships** on January 20-22, 2023. **If you are not the contact for U11 in your community, please forward this information to the right person – Thank you!**

TEAMS

It looks like we will have **8 teams** participating in the championships. **If your team can make it to the earlier games on Friday please contact hjminorhockey@gmail.com.** If you have a limited number of players, we will match you up with more players or another team. **DEADLINE to submit your team roster for the tournament is Friday, January 6, 2023 – please email hjminorhockey@gmail.com.**

GAME SCHEDULE

We plan to get the final schedule out by **Friday, January 13th, 2023**. Expect the first game to start around 3:00pm Friday and the last game to finish around 4:00pm Sunday. The plan is for all teams to play at least one game on Friday, at least two games on Saturday and at least one game Sunday morning.

The playoffs will be scheduled for Sunday, but could start as early as **Saturday night**.

RULES

The Playing Rules shall be those of Hockey Yukon (YAHA), as applicable to Minor Hockey and will be distributed by Hockey Yukon.

GAMES

The game shall commence within 10 minutes of the scheduled time.

Games shall be:

- Three periods
- 5 minute warm up before each game
- 1st period – 20 minute running time
- 2nd period – 20 minute running time
- 3rd period – Start the period with 20 minute. (17 minutes running time. **Last 3 minutes stop time** unless the goal spread is 5 or more.

TIMEKEEPING

Each team is responsible for supplying one timekeeper for each game so that there are two people in the booth at all times. Please find the timekeeper for your team in advance for the tournament.

REFEREES

Referees must be Hockey Canada certified and will be organized by Hockey Yukon Referee Coordinator.

DRESSING ROOMS

Players must remove their equipment from the dressing rooms when they are not playing.

ROSTERS

Please send us your jersey numbers and players' names in numerical order, as well as your jersey colours and coaches' names by Friday, January 6. The jersey numbers must be sorted numerically so that we can make up the timekeeping labels in advance. All players must be registered through Hockey Yukon/BC Hockey.

OVERAGED PLAYERS

If you need over-aged players to make up a team, you are allowed a maximum of four. They can only be one-year over-age and they must play at the U11 level. If they appear to be ringers they could be stopped from playing. This would be decided at the Coaches Meeting (organized and chaired by HY (YAHA) Friday night after the last game or at a subsequent meeting.
