



CLUB SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT POLICY (MINOR AND MAJOR PLAYERS)

POLICY: CLUB SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT

Purpose: To inform the members, players and coaches of what equipment is made available at no charge to a team, and the associated responsibility to the club for the use of this equipment.

Goalie Equipment

The Hornets will supply each team with a set of goalie equipment. The responsibility for the equipment is assigned to the head coach or team manager if there is no permanent goalie assigned to the team. Permanent goalies will be responsible for their equipment assigned to them for the season.

The responsible coach or goalie will sign out all equipment from the equipment coordinator.

Given the cost of goalie equipment (ie >\$1500 for Midget), a signed waiver will be required of each goalie family (in cases of a permanent/designated goalie), or by the team manager (in cases of a non-designated goalie). This waiver is intended to cover costs of equipment lost or damaged from circumstances beyond normal wear and tear of seasonal play.

One goalie stick will be handed out with each set of equipment, except for permanent Bantam, Midget and Junior goalies who will be required to supply their own personal goalie stick.

Goalie equipment supplied by the Horne

- Chest/body Armour

- Goalie Pants

- Shin Pads

- Goalie Jock

- Goalie Equipment Bag

- Throat Guard

- Goalie Stick (optional).

All goalie equipment must be returned to the equipment coordinator no later than **September 15. There shall be NO Exceptions unless pre-approved by the Equipment Coordinator.** This is to ensure that the equipment is repaired (as required) and cleaned prior to being stored and made ready for the next season.

Persons/Teams wishing to sign out goalie equipment for the Winter Lacrosse League or the Hornets Winter Camps must contact the Equipment Coordinator to make arrangements.

Team Jerseys:

The Hornets supply each team with one set of Jerseys for the regular season games and a second color if required (and available) for tournaments and provincials.

All jerseys are signed out to the coach or manager under the following terms and conditions:

Jerseys are handed out in a clean organized condition. They must be returned in the same condition. **Jerseys must be wash and numerically ordered in the bag.**

Jerseys are **NOT** to be handed out to the players for the season. Each team should assign an Equipment Manager to maintain the team jerseys. This person should be responsible for bringing the jerseys to the games; collecting the jerseys afterwards, and for the general up-keep of the jerseys, including washing them and any minor repairs.

All Equipment pick ups/ exchanges / returns are done by appointment only. Please email or call the hornets Equipment Coordinator to arrange a time.

Name bars are NOT permitted on any Jerseys.

Jerseys are NOT to be worn for practices or scrimmages.

Equipment damaged through the normal wear and tear of the season will be repaired or replaced by Hornets at no charge. Please contact the Equipment Coordinator. In some cases jerseys may be in need of minor repair. We ask that you find a volunteer(s) from your team to perform minor repairs as required. Should you determine that a jersey is in need of professional repair or replacement, please contact the Equipment Coordinator.

All jerseys (Cleaned and Organized) are due back to the equipment coordinator no later than **September 1 - NO Exceptions unless pre-approved by the Equipment Coordinator.** Failure to return by this date will result in the entire teams \$100.00/player jersey deposits being cashed.

If the Coach has collected all but one or two of the jerseys and is having trouble getting them returned. Contact the Equipment Coordinator prior to the deadline to make arrangement to get the jersey(s) returned or have the cheque(s) cashed for the missing jersey(s) only.

Game Balls:

The Hornets will supply each team with game balls for the season. Any leftover lacrosse balls from the season must be returned to the Equipment Director/Coordinator when returning the jerseys at the end of the season.

Other Equipment Available:

The Hornets have other equipment available for teams and tournaments as listed below. This equipment can be signed out for a limited time and is expected to be returned on time so others can use them if booked.

Evaluation Pinnies

Pylons (for tournaments and camps only)

Medical Kit (must be returned at the end of the season or a \$25.00 fee will be assessed to the team).

General Requirements:

Hornets **cannot** accept substitute equipment for lost/damaged equipment without the approval of the Equipment Director/Coordinator.

Lost or damaged due to neglect/misuse/unreturned equipment is the sole responsibility of the team and/or player. Should this situation occur, please contact the Equipment Director/Coordinator to discuss the matter.
