Hello Hornet Managers!

It's Alvina with Mojo Sports Photography; we will be doing league photos again this year for Hornets Lacrosse. We will operate everything very similar to last couple of years so a lot of you may already know our process, if not, below are some details to give you a heads up on what to expect. With the venue change there are a few slight changes so please do read through this in its entirety.

Please forward the **parent photo day and ordering information** document to your team. The Managers/Coaches only information can be shared with the coaches prior to photo day so we can have an organized, seamless photo day for all involved!

Managers/Coaches Only Information

How you can help (most seem like no brainers, but we'll mention them anyways):

Managers/coaches, we ask that you help by keeping your team volume to a respectable level as it can get loud with 2 teams in the room at once and players need to be able to hear our staff's instructions. Please (only if this happens) ask your team not to distract the person having their photo taken as we only have a small amount of time per player to capture a good photo.

Double check your photo time/venue. Have your team arrive 15 minutes early. There will be a parent volunteer who will direct your team when they can come up to the photoshoot area (5 min before your start time) so QR codes can be organized.

Please have the jersey parent arrive early if players are not responsible for their own jersey. Please have players come picture ready with their lacrosse stick, and glove and proper foot attire as feet may be seen in the team picture.

NO BAGS/BALLS/DRESSING WILL BE PERMITTED UPSTAIRS.

Please wait as a team until the parent volunteer gives you the go ahead to enter the photoshoot area. Please have them in line arranged with goalies at the front of the line, then from shortest to tallest player.

A volunteer or Mojo staff member will greet the incoming team with QR codes so they can be put in order to correspond to the players in line.

Person #1 (organizer): It would be helpful if you can have players lined up from shortest to tallest PRIOR to entering the photoshoot area. If you can put the QR codes provided in order corresponding to the line up order. **DO NOT GIVE THE QR CODES TO THE PLAYERS**. Please return the QR codes to the staff member who will be posing the players for individual photos. We will double check that the QR code name matches the player name as players come for their individual photos.

The goal is to have teams come upstairs and be ready to walk right into doing photos once the codes are in order.

Person #2 (equipment): Once the individual photo is taken if this person can be on the "exist" side of the individual station taking sticks from players and placing them at the door exit as they will not be needed for the team photo. Players can grab them on their way out. Please have players wait along the wall in height order for the team photo (keepers/goalies at the front of the line).

Manager: Please be sure to get the QR codes from our staff prior to your team leaving, these can be handed out to parents as a secondary or back up option (if we are given an incorrect email address the gallery email we send will not make it to the parent), they can then access our online shop using the QR code for their player once the gallery has been opened for your league.

We truly do appreciate your help in making sure your team follows our instructions to ensure we can stay organized and on schedule. We couldn't do this without your help and support. Thank you all for volunteering your time, talents and efforts to your team!
