Hughenden Minor Hockey 2023-2024 Parent Information Sheet

For players **new** to hockey, please contact the Registrar, Candace Adams, prior to completing the online form. The new player will need a Hockey Canada ID number to complete the process. New players also need to provide a government-issued ID so the Registrar can verify the birthdate, and create the Hockey ID. Texting a photo of either a birth certificate or Alberta Health card is acceptable. Other required information for new players – parent(s)'s names, emails, home/cell numbers, physical address/land location, and mailing address.

Parents of **returning** players can create a profile on the **new HCR 3.0**, which replaces and combines eHockey and the previous Hockey Canada Registry. Parents can then log into their accounts to obtain their child's Hockey ID. For parents looking for their Respect In Sport Parent course status, log in to your Respect account.
