 - Covid impacted team size decisions, IMHA went larger team size than normal in case players were in isolation, to not to leave a team with too few players
 - Carefully monitor registration numbers coming in for 2022/23. IMHA does not want to turn kids away while managing team size.

- Thank you to volunteers, board, managers & officials for the great work in 2021/22
- Ice users meeting is May 31st, 2022 & we need to have our ice time requests completed by May 20th, 2022
- CAHL had their Annual General Meeting this past Monday, highlights that may impact IMHA:
 - 7 associations have joined
 - They have indicated we will not go past Edmonton line for north travel. If so, this will help keep travel manageable
 - Discussion on a U9 division. IMHA can consider depending on registration numbers AND location for games (travel impact). Hope to know by July
 - Looking at having a U18 non-checking tier
- Must work on more checking clinics for the kids that have not hit yet due to Covid taking away their hitting season (2020/21) &/or being in a non-hitting U15 tier last season (2021/22) and now moving to U18

9. **New Business**

- a) Larry Reid Memorial Coaching Development Fund (LRMCDF)
 - Background:1962/63 Innisfail Pontiacs Midget Hockey Club was coached by Larry Reid.
 This team alumni created a fund in his name with assistance from IMHA Executive Board.
 Going on 5 years of partnership. The dividends from the large investment go to IMHA for coach development (ex., Edge Boss equipment for example & bring in coach trainers)
 - In last few months, due to the alumni aging, they transitioned the fund to IMHA Executive Board. IMHA will manage the same way & retain same conditions of usage. If IMHA folds, the investment money goes to Hockey Alberta for scholarships. Getting back acct & Qtrade account set-up to manage fund.
 - Need coach development role filled we have money available to spend on training
- b) Encouragement of Assistant Coaches taking Referee Course
 - Len Istace (Referee-in-Chief) recommends assistant coaches/coaches to take referee courses and officiate a handful of games. (Will get paid back cost of referee course after 5 games.)
 - There are only positives to doing this (prevent referee shortages, help them see new
 rules in place, assist in dealing with parents that shout at officials, provide mentorship for
 the younger officials on the ice with them & demonstrate a high commitment to the sport)
 - If 8-10 coaches step up and each officiate 1 game a month or 5 a season, it greatly alleviates official shortages & lets our young athletes play
