RAMP support is helpful but not super quick to reply so things are moving, albeit slowly.

Waiting on decisions on certain items before I can post registration - I have added these items to the agenda for Thursday.

Also waiting for a decision on a merchant account from Jesse and Adam. We can discuss at the meeting if other folks would like to weigh in.

Other associations have their field registration up and running so I am hoping once I have these answers, I can get the link published and on the website in the next few days. An email will go out to all members once registration is open.

There are still a few outstanding refunds from box season that I am following up on.

I am working with Dawn on the girls summer camp registration and chasing down payments. We have 17 registered so far. Trying to get a hold of someone at Out of the Blue to coordinate shirts. Neither Dawn nor I have had any luck getting any answers so I recommend we go elsewhere.

It looks like the RAMP registration system can be set up to create camps (and tournaments). We would be able to track camp registration, waivers, payments etc. Will be exploring these options as I get more familiar with the new system. There

may be an extra fee associated, but it might be worth paying to keep the information in one place, and to save manpower in chasing down people for payment.

Head Coach Box – Curt Morwick

Head Referee - Rob Cook

Overall I was very pleased with the performance of our officials. The number of complaints were minimal. Most of them came from the Nanaimo coaches at the Bateman tournament.

On that subject, what a great learning weekend for our young refs. Having the majority, 90%, of the games with 3 refs on the floor was fantastic. There were very few complaints from parents or coaches and I think this was attributed to have the extra eyes watching the game.

Thank you to the executive for approving the funds for this. Our refs gained so much experience from this one tournament as we were able to get them on the floor for many games.

Going forward, I would like to see, JDF, using 3 officials for both the U11 and U13 age groups.

Because this was a good year for the officials, I'm confident that the majority of refs will return next season and the we get a good number of new refs.

Referee Allocator box- Cass Jutting

In general, the season went fairly well from my perspective. Any feedback is appreciated.

A few things to note in the latter part of the season:

- -the importance of timely ref payments and communication around cash vs e-transfer payments. Some of the missed communication is likely due to the assumption I just magically know things. Maybe e-transfer responsibility can shift to head manager and allocator? Separate account like teams have?
- -the communication around tiering and playdowns games and allocating officials was—absent. I believe VIMLC didn't communicate with official allocators around the changes that would occur because of tiering, in particular. This resulted in a 17C game being

missed exacerbated by the 17C group not existing in RAMP. Still a few lessons to learn in using RAMP but after this season I am hoping the noted issues are worked out.

-I believe some sort of officials meeting for the association would be helpful at beginning of the season. My biggest concern is that the officials aren't using RAMP for their availability, and I want them to understand that my side of RAMP relies on them doing their part. The result is I just can't be bothered to even try to schedule them because they always decline assignments. For things like payments, they should know what to expect for types of games (association, playdowns, etc). Some didn't have a bank account, for example. Again, communication of expectations (maybe Rob's and mine?) to reinforce whatever they are taught in clinic which isn't likely much related to "admin".

I don't have very much to say for right now the raffle is completed and was successful. I have sent the numbers to Rochelle for her gaming report.

Working with Jill in preparation to start field season. I expect my next report will have more information.

Floor Allocator – Kyla Pedlow

Playdowns were a challenge this year. Overall there was a general breakdown in communication from the Island as to how they wanted Playdown games booked. Some teams were responsible for booking their own games, some teams had their Commissioner/Island doing it. It would be helpful in future years for this to be communicated and organized as soon as teams declare in May so that I know what floortime needs to be booked. This year we had some teams finding out the day before their playdowns began, when they would be playing. It's just not necessary to be so last minute when we know which teams have declared weeks before that.

WSPR has asked that we not go onto the floor until our allocated times, even if the floor isn't being used. For Example, we have a game scheduled for a 6:30pm start, the floor is booked starting at 6:00pm, however teams start warm up at 5-5:30pm. This means that maintenance has to stop doing any work they had planned to do up until the booked time of 6:00pm. I'm not sure how we stop teams from doing this? If anyone has any ideas?

I'll be working with Nikyla in the coming weeks to transition all Field Allocating duties over to her.

Field Allocator - Nikila Cyr

- **Female Tournament:** Unfortunately, City Centre Park could not accommodate our request to host this at their facility. Maybe we can chat other ideas?
- **Field Contracts:** Met with the Field Committee last night, and I am working with WSPR to secure our assessment field time as well as our field season contract. I should receive their offers for field time by mid-July.

Tournament Coordinator - Brittney Corkery

Tournament season is officially wrapped up and I think we did fairly well! First off a HUGE thanks to everyone on the executive and within our lacrosse association family who helped with the tournament, whether it was volunteering their time during the weekend or helping out ahead of time to get things organized so we were ready for tournament weekend.

Between the Bateman and the Rumble we should see a profit of just over \$6,000. I am still waiting to hear what the amount will be given to us from the Four Points Hotel for using them as a host hotel. Based on the numbers I was given I'm expecting around \$800.

I received some great feedback for both the Bateman and the rumble tournament and now having done this for about the second year in a row I know what works and what doesn't.

The u7/u9 wrap up tournament I felt went really well. We were able to pull off that tournament including box time, medals and ref fees for under \$1,000.

I'm looking forward to next tournament season and really moving forward with the successful points of the tournament and hopefully figuring out alternatives to the parts that maybe didn't run so smoothly.

From looking at my budget spreadsheet for the last two years of tournaments it looks like each tournament cost roughly just under \$11,000 to put on so that gives us a good idea on a spending budget going forward knowing what we need to keep within and really pushing those 50/50 and silent auction sales as that's what boost our profit.

I have some ideas and suggestions like potentially changing the date of the rumble for next year's tournament season but I'll throw those into the agenda probably in January/February when we get closer to applying for tournaments.

We were able to get City of Langford and Council Member Keith Yacucha to attend ceremonial faceoffs for our U7/U9 Debbie Cooper Memorial Jamboree and thank the City of Langford for their funding this year.
