The has been a fair bit of movement with our accounts the past months, mostly due to field registrations coming in.

We are almost finished the set-up of our RAMP Merchant Accounts in support of association's registration process.

Our Fiscal Year ended on July 31 and we have started the process of closing out the old year. There are a number of activities required to reconcile the old year. This will take a few months and the goal is to have everything closed out well prior to the November AGM.

Registrar – Jean Gallagher

The new registration system comes with numerous challenges. It is taking me HOURS longer to process registrations compared to previous years.

I will not bore you with details but there is a lot more manual intervention due to things like pending merchant account, waitlists, sibling discounts and birth certificate verification. Don't even get me started on verification of catchment boundaries. I am hopeful these will improve over time, however anticipate next season will still need a lot of time to process registration due to the volume box generates, and the slowness of the system.

Syncing registration with the JDF website is requiring a lot of Ramp support, by phone, email and trial and error. I hope to have it (mostly) sorted by the weekend so we can use Ramp to email families following assessments instead of one of us doing it the old fashioned way.

This past week especially I've been fielding a number of emails about missed assessments, withdrawals, practice inquiries, new families looking for information and releases/play downs, and as a result, anticipate the registration numbers will fluctuate slightly in the coming days. I've been reaching out to the appropriate executive members for help where possible...It is much appreciated.
