The season has officially started and it has been an interesting start to say the least. The Island released a schedule that consisted of 3-6 regular season games for each team, with the remaining games to be self-scheduled. Most teams have begun self-scheduling and are learning as they go. It has certainly not been seamless, but we're all doing our best.

I created a spreadsheet for the whole Island to use for self-scheduling in hopes of making it easier to schedule games, and minimize the amount of communication back and forth to book games. It seems to be working well for the teams that are using it. Commissioners, field allocators and the webmaster are all using it as well.

We've had some rocky starts with our U<sub>15</sub> and U<sub>18</sub> divisions. I believe that U<sub>15</sub> is under control now, and we're working to getting U<sub>18</sub> back on track.

This past weekend we had three teams participate in the Westcoast Cup in Maple Ridge. U18T2 brought home Silver, U13T1 brought home bronze, and U11T1 brought home silver. What a great start to our season! The next tournament is in just over a week in Langley at Thunderstrike where we have quite a few teams heading over.

- Jerseys.... We just don't have enough. Optically the girls being the ones to have to wear the practice pinnies to games isn't going over well. But I think they look great in my opinion.
- Our older teams now have 25+ on the roster and can only dress 25. It's a tricky
  spot as we could not manage to split the teams and run two. So, we do what we
  must.

One potentially actionable item is looking into lines for the velodrome to be painted on. Everything else is just learning for next year.

#### **Review of Old Business:**

- Booking floor time and planning for box assessments

\$30,000 cost for box and field try outs in 2025. We need to do something differently.

Bring back \$25 try out fees for those wishing to "try out for the A level teams". Balancing teams, just scrimmages and then have funds for refs which helps get them back in the groove.

U11 tiering or not still TBD by VIMLC. If U11 is tiered, try out fee would apply for those wishing to try out for A team.

Minimum registrations 48-50 to make it worth while running try outs.

Grant funding can be used for try for free and community programs, co-ed and female initiatives.

Drop down box to check on registration intent to try out.

Try for free events, other venue- outdoor box, school gym, RB gym or indoor turf. Anything cheaper than Eagle Ridge.

U9 and U7 no need for assessments

Try outs different than assessments, players have to show up to be ranked.

Align policy on website assessments vs try-outs for transparency and available to all. Kyla and Jill to work on documents.

Closed assessments went well, player feedback said they were able to focus more U13-U18.
