President's report

- a. Zone Programs This has been difficult since last meeting, we have had teleconferences. There are currently 6 new presidents, 3 of them in South Island. The new presidents were confused with how the process would go. We are currently trying to discuss the terms of engagement. 4 South Island Associations had decided to form a tier one team. They have since agreed to reverse that until the engagement is understood. All presidents need to be together to discuss what this will look like. Meeting was then held, small associations with good players who have never had a chance to play tier one, and this system would alleviate that. Discussions were held; moderate interest but every association had different needs and thoughts. We need to all get on the same page or next year BC Hockey is going to come in and own the whole program. That program would look like this; Victoria, JDF, Sooke and Kerry Park together, then Peninsula, Saanich and Racquet Club would be together. We need to provide a financial alternative to academies that some families simply can't afford. A first draft is being drawn up, so we will wait for that. Tryouts 2018/19 will start August 18/19. Host associations will be IDF and Racquet Club. If approved, players that the options. A board cannot forbid players from going.
