  - U11 6 or 7 teams
  - U13 7 teams
  - U15 6 teams
  - U18 6 teams
  - U21 1 team (2 goalies and 13 skaters goal is to increase to 20 players)
- Coaching first call gone out; hiccup with reg form but applications are coming in; tier one coaches named
- Parent presentation night 25 ppl; good feedback; suggested to do it again, love to do it in person. Educating parents = focus of BC Hockey

Ice contracts – request submitted to WSPR and will find out in July when they offer ice

contracts

- WSPR changing how they allocate Ice asking for historical record of numbers; % of member that resides on Westshore; WSPR needs this information because they have so many clients looking to buy ice. They want to ensure that the correct users (i.e. tax payers) are getting the ice.
