My name is Jamie O'Hare and I'm thrilled to be this year's Kanata Cubs 13U coach. Over the last 5 years I've been an assistant coach in the Cubs association working with a great team of coaches and executives. In addition to coaching baseball, I've spent 11 seasons as a head coach in various hockey associations.

I'm very much looking forward to an exciting season that will (hopefully) be 100% back to normal without any covid delays or protocol. The season will consist of:

- Winter sessions (January April) at Sooner's MegaDome on Abbott St. in Stittsville
 - I encourage your player to attend all sessions so we can hit the ground running in May when we are outdoors. I understanding many players participate in winter sports/activities and may miss sessions occasionally.
- 1 to 2 games per week
- 1 to 2 practices per week
- 4 tournaments (subject to change)
 - Away and local

This year we will continue to take the next step in growth with a focus on development on and off the field. I am a firm believer in building self esteem in the players; with self belief comes incredible things. In addition to building self esteem, given the stage the players are at the focus will be on:

- Refining the details
 - Focus and practice the little things that make the difference between making plays and not.
- Ownership of self and development
 - A big believer that sport is a foundation for many of life's adventures, we'll encourage the player to be active participants in their development
 - There will be four 1 on 1 player meetings to discuss things like goals, challenges, successes and areas of focus.

Try outs for next season will consist of two sessions: Sunday September 25th and October 2nd at Frank McDonald field. Both sessions take place from 3-5:30 pm. Following the sessions those selected will be issued offer letter the week of October 3rd . I'd ask those that receive letters to please respond within 48 hours.
