Accountability- It is very important we recognize the good things we do on and off the ice. That being said it is just as important to be accountable for the wrongs we do on and off the ice. Coaches are included in this. The only way we will learn how to succeed as a group is to learn from our mistakes and reset.

Fun- These girls need to know it is just a game at the end of the day. They will learn lifelong lessons and gain lifelong friends. We will always find ways to keep it fun for them in practice and at team functions. Giving them choices in what fun activities they want to partake in is always a good way to keep smiles on their faces.

Development Plan (Always Fluid)

Will consists of three phases that we will talk about with the team once made. One thing I can say is Skill, Skating, IQ, and Compete will always be a focus in practice and games. More systematic and situational play will be implemented that will add to the foundation of their game. Being consistent with fundamentals along with pace of play in practice and games will always be at the forefront of our coaching plan.
