 - 1. Increase in players this year up 30%
 - 2. New division U7, total of 6 teams more than last season.
 - 1. Had to find new field space to accommodate.
 - 3. Learn to play clinic and Fall Ball were new initiatives. UBCO skills clinic was well attended. Plan to do more skills clinics at no cost.
 - 4. Coaching clinics offered. This coming season coaches will be required to have community coaching certification to coach with KMFS.

 - 2. Meeting with city this week to put together proposal to have field 7 & 8 have dirt fields, and 3 &4 redo the gravel, improve water access, renovate bleachers, have city take more ownership of the park maintenance.
 - 10. Volunteer development
 - 1. Many new volunteers.

- 11. Moving from SportsEngine to Ramp for next season, will provide team messaging through Ramp.
- 12. New umpire in chief this year, goal is to get more umpires this season.
 - 1. Have increased the pay for umpires.
- 13. Registration will open in December, close in January.
- 14. Softball BC has changed pay structure and has increased costs per player registration.
 - 1. Try to keep fees the same as last year, had fee increases last season.
- 15. Michelle Kirkbright stepped down as treasurer. Barb Thody has been appointed as new treasurer for the remainder of the term (1 year).
- 4. Financial Review
 - 1. Will used fundraising money to look at funding more professional development for athletes and coaches, as well as improvements to the park.
