Can we use it for Spring ringette?- not really, it will be in next years budget. Can we pre pay goalie clinic etc? Request for funds for two groups we formed this year- (from Tessa) -mixed team U14 ice cost- was only a few ice times (about \$200 or lesswas to give U16 competition), - the U12 CI South group- 9 players from Kelowna, about \$600 in ice from our program, and parents paid as well. Typically teams pay ice fees/jerseys, KRA pays ref fees.
