Equipment- Graham -a parent reached out to see if we have any interest in purchasing their son's goalie equipment before they sell it somewhere else. 26 pads and 27 pads, still in good condition, good for U12, possibly U14. She was asking approx. \$100 for one pair and \$200 for the other. Tracie indicated that we do have money in our budget for this and Graham will consider these after he goes through our inventory once everything is returned. -KRA has provided goalie gear to U12 and under. We do have quite a bit in sizes 22 and 24. -when the season ends, all equipment needs to be turned in at the end of the season. 	-Springette: Able to get 7 more ice times than last year which is resulting in more costs for the players but also gives us more groups. U10/U12 first year (2015, 2016, 2017) and U12 second year/U14 (2014, 2013, 2012) -starts the last Monday of March and goes until June 23 <sup>rd</sup> -\$129 per player for registration -spoken with some coaches from last year and many are available to join again -registration opening asap -Janet will look into RAMP for registration -Brooklyn will send budget to Tracie (ice is \$1890, \$280 for Power Skating, \$75 for TeamSnap, \$260 for coaches, \$65 for year end party for a total cost of 2570.85 per group. -info to Janet and Linette -\$30 approx. for a jersey for those new players who do not have a jersey -Open to KRA players only, 20 spots for each group

	-Yearly compilation usage; look at the one we did last year to see if we want to make any changes and get it sent out shortly after provincials.	
	-Coach complaint received. They want to remain anonymous so we cannot address it with the coach directly. We will wait to see if anything more comes from the coach surveys once they are sent out.

	AGM -Birgitta will look into venues and pricing and options. -Not on the weekend.	

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-AGM committee needs to be formed. A FUN family has reached out to see how they can help with the AGM as they weren't able to do their Sweetheart hours. -Any ideas on how to bring people forward to be nominated at the AGM for our board. Update job descriptions and get them out.		
Request for ref exempt from Sweetheart volunteer duties (like last year) -there wasn't an exemption for refs this year (or board members). No recollection of refs being exempt last year. -According to the schedule, it looks like she was only an official for one game during sweetheart but she is saying she did two. -we do struggle for officials and if she would have been an official for a number of games and helped out in that way, we may have been in a position of giving her an exemption but not for one or two games over the tournament -in the future, officials can discuss their availability officiating and not being able to volunteer with the Referee in Chief who can then bring this to the Sweetheart Committee to see if an official can be exempt as they are needed for a number of games as an official		
Support for KRA athletes going to Westerns and CRC -2 KRA U14 players going to Westerns in BC -We will confirm how many U16 players are going to Westerns from KRA but approx. 9 -CRC -U16 one KRA -U19 three KRA players who did pay AP registration		
Last year we did \$150 for the players going to Westerns, and \$250 for CRC.		
Tracie put forward a motion to provide \$150 for each KRA player attending Westerns this year. Jenni seconded the motion. One abstains. The rest vote yes.		
Jenni put forward a motion to provide \$250 for each KRA player attending CRC's in eastern Canada this season. Linette seconded the motion. One abstains. The rest vote yes.		
Sweetheart debriefs: -many comments received that this was one of the best tournaments they ever attended -two complaints came in. One at the U16 level which has been dealt with. One at the open level which Jenni has discussed with RBC. -refs were happy, everything worked out at the arenas.		

-good number of teams -2026 date decided Jan 30-Feb 1 -some games did not have enough time in the hour ice time to get through the 20-minute ice time for U16 and older but it often depends on the number of penalties being called. -Silent auction discussion: the team baskets did not make much money considering what the teams spent on them. We have been doing the online auction the past 2-3 years. We have done the basket raffles in the past where you put a ticket in buckets but we were audited and were told this is an illegal way of doing things that goes against our gaming license. We can look at other options next year and if we do make any changes for next year.
