

KRA PLAYER & PARENT JERSEY AGREEMENT

I, _____, am accepting responsibility for the team jersey(s) number _____ in size _____ and will ensure they are properly cared for and that they are returned within 1 week following the last team game.

Every Kelowna Ringette player is provided with both a home and away jersey. Taking care of jerseys is key to helping us save money as an association. This Jersey Agreement will help ensure that the jerseys are kept and maintained in the best physical condition they can. Normal wear and tear is expected.

Please note that a few Associations only have one colour so it is best to carry both colours with you when attending games.

Care of Jerseys

*Jerseys must be hung to dry after washing - do not put in dryer or use any fabric softeners.

*Nothing is to be ironed on the jersey.

*Please hand stitch the C / A with long stitches so it's easy for you to take it off at the end of the season.

*DO NOT use Febreze or any other fragrance on the jerseys as they can damage the jerseys.

*Please do not use Gatorade or any other coloured drinks in water bottles during games. These drinks can permanently stain the jerseys.

Returning Jerseys

At the end of the season, please return your jerseys to your Team Manager (washed and on hangers). The jerseys go back to the Director of Managers & Jerseys at the rink on an agreed upon time, preferably, within one week of the team's last game.

It is the responsibility of yourself and your team to return the jerseys in a timely manner and in good condition. If the jersey is not returned or is not in acceptable condition, KRA will request a quote for replacement and an invoice will be sent to the player/parent it was signed out to. This amount must be paid before the player will be allowed to register the following season. ** Please indicate any damage so a repair can be made before next season.
