



## Kelowna United Football Club Parent Agreement

The Kelowna United Football Club (KUFC) provides opportunity for youth to learn and play the game of soccer at a competitive level in British Columbia. Our Club consists of over 500 youths, 40 coaches, senior staff and a Board of Directors.

If a child is selected to play for KUFC, he/she will be placed on a team by the Technical Director. This selection process assures that each player:

- receives the level of training best suited to improve their skills,
- is provided the opportunities to play and improve
- is placed in a competitive atmosphere with a goal of succeeding.
- is supported when possible to play at provincial or national levels.

KUFC encourages all parents or guardians:

- To participate in all social aspects of the team's development,
- To participate as a supporter in all games,
- To encourage all players to play in a sporting way, with enthusiasm and love for the game.
- To avoid contacting coaches when discussing game tactics or team decisions,
- To allow referees to interpret the rules of the game and allow officials to adjudicate the games without intimidation.
- To discuss issues or concerns that may arise in a formal manner with the Technical Director or the Board of Directors.

It is KUFC's firm position that no player is ever responsible for the actions of their parents.

It is KUFC policy that if a player's parent or guardian is not respectful of the above criteria, then the team coach, with the support of the Technical Director and KUFC Disciplinary Committee, must enact the following:

1. Suspend those parents not to participate in any team activities, whether on or off the field.
2. If, during a suspension, there continues to be disregard to this policy, then the Disciplinary Committee will consider suspension of the player from the KUFC soccer program.
