General

Kerry Park Minor Hockey Association (KPMHA) is pleased to sponsor scholarships to our graduating players and/or officials. KPMHA Board of Directors approve successful applicants upon the recommendations of the KPMHA Scholarship Committee. The Committee will not consist of any parent or coach of the applicants. The Committee may choose to recommend awarding a scholarship to more than one applicant. A successful application must show proof of registration before the scholarship is disbursed to them.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, graduating players/officials must have been registered with KPMHA within the last two (2) years. Consideration will be given to players/officials who have participated up to the U18 level with a minimum of four (4) years of minor hockey experience with KPMHA. Applicants must be graduating from BC high school (public, private, or correspondence) and attend a post-secondary institution within 18 months of graduation. Applicants are encouraged to review the full list of eligibility requirements on the KPMHA's [website](#).

Qualifications

The applicant should epitomize the qualities that KPMHA considers foremost: Sportsmanship, good work ethic and leadership.

How to Apply

The applicant' application must include:

1. Written statement identifying:
 - Self introduction paragraph.
 - Stating their chosen career/ education goal and why they are passionate in pursuing this.
 - Identifying volunteer work.
 - Financial need.
2. Provide one reference letter from a hockey coach, referee, team manager or KPMHA supervisor.
3. BC School transcripts.
