## COVID protocols

The following information conveys the protocols for Kitchener Ringette Association arenas. Please take time to review this information prior to arriving at the arena.

### **ARRIVAL AND EXITS**

There is no time restriction for access to the arena. However, changerooms will be available 30min prior to the ice-time. When leaving the building, please be aware of designated exits that allow for one-way flow.

### **PROOF OF VACCINATION**

18+ and all non-sport individuals 12 to 17 must show proof of full vaccination and photo identification. For additional specific information on City of Kitchener arena policies for vaccination, please use the following link:

You do not need to show proof of vaccination if you are included in the groups below:

- children under 12 years of age (important: parents or guardians supervising children must show proof of vaccination)
- **youth under 18 years of age who are actively participating in ringette**
- those with a documented medical exemption

### **MASKS**

As required by the province and City of Kitchener, everyone who enters the arena must wear a mask/face covering while in the facility. Participants can remove their mask just prior to putting on their helmets and going on the ice.

### **WARMUPS**

Warmups are permitted inside the arena, with masks and physical distancing.

### **AMENITIES**

Dressing rooms are available with no capacity limits. Showers are also available. Washrooms for spectators are available.

### **SPECTATORS**

There are no restricted capacity limits for spectators. See above regarding vaccination requirements.

### **SCREENING AND TRACING**

Visiting teams are responsible to screen and contact trace players and coaching staff per RO policies. Spectators will be screened upon entry by City of Kitchener staff.
