

FAQ: Fundraising Fee at Registration

What is the extra fundraising line that I have to select in order to register my player?

You spoke, and we listened. We know it can be difficult to come up with \$400/\$600/\$800+ right after Christmas so, we are collecting the Fundraising fee right now. Therefore, when raffle tickets are handed out, families will keep the proceeds from their ticket sales as the money has already been handed in.

In collecting the funds first, we are also working to ensure there is less stress and fatigue on our volunteers (committees, managers and coaches).

Why don't we just increase everyone's fees by \$200 and get rid of Fundraising?

Hockey can be expensive, and the last thing we want to do is make it too expensive for players to register and even begin playing in the first place. Also, this was proposed at the AGM, but the congregation, and the board, like the ability to have a chance to get their money back.

I only have one player registering. Does that mean I have to give KMH Fundraising another \$200, when I get my tickets?

No, in effort to ease financial obligations and stress on our volunteers KMH has voted to make the Fundraising requirement a flat \$200/player. There will be extra tickets that will be printed and are strongly encouraged to sell as every dollar helps the association.

If KMH is not collecting as much in ticket proceeds, will they still be doing Cash of the Month?

The board is looking at many different Fundraising options to keep our fundraisers fresh and won't be finalized until a Fundraising Coordinator is in place
