Scholarship Policy

Policy Statement

The KESA Soccer Scholarship's Policy provides for annual scholarships to support and champion the efforts of youth soccer participants entering studies at a post-secondary institution.

Purpose

To support selected KESA Soccer youth participants pursuit of their post-secondary objectives.

Standards

- KESA Soccer will establish the number of scholarships on an annual basis.
- Scholarships will be awarded to youth who are currently participating in KESA soccer as a youth player, referee, or coach for 3 or more years at the time of graduation.
- Recipient Qualification:
 - Proceeding from Grade 12 to a post-secondary institution.
 - Must have demonstrated good citizenship, personality, and leadership.
- All applicants must follow the scholarship application process to be considered for a KESA Soccer Scholarship. KESA Soccer reserves the right to forego processing any applications from applicants who do not follow the procedures in place.
- The scholarship funds will be withheld until such time the recipient provides proof of payment of tuition either the first semester or in full as well as proof of enrolment.
- A scholarship that is awarded, but not availed of within 3 years of the award winner's high school graduation year will be deemed to be null and void.
 - The scholarship award will be then awarded to a new candidate the following year.

Selection

- Scholarship Selection Committee will not enter into correspondence with an applicant or their agent.
- The decision of the committee is final.
