REFEREE CLINIC

KEYSA is hosting an Entry Level Referee Clinic. This clinic is the entry point into 11 a-side soccer. Once you complete the clinic, you are classified as a Youth Referee (for 14 and 15 yrs old) or a District Referee (16+ yrs ol) and you can either be a Referee or an Assistant Referee in a 11 a-side soccer games.

There are two components:

- On-line theory component: self-guided law-based modules + one webinar (via Zoom) + online exam
- On-field practical component: a 3.5 hour on-field session (on April 23)

COST: 135.75 (if you are a registered KEYSA player, you are refunded)

As we are hosting more and more tournaments, there are many opportunities throughout the year within the region to put your referee skills to action and earn a bit of money!
