

Lacombe Minor Baseball Association (LMBA) – Coaching Requirements

NEW - NCCP Requirements

All coaches MUST be registered in the NCCP system.

Simply go to http://nccp.baseball.ca/register.php and register.

New coaches will be required to pay \$37.45 to enter the system and receive access to the Coach Initiation in Sport Module. Coaches will then have a choice to take either <u>Coach Initiation in Baseball</u> <u>(Rally Cap) or Coach Initiation in Baseball (Fundamentals)</u>, depending on what level they plan to coach. Completing Coach Initiation in Baseball (Fundamentals) Online Module will enable coaches to register for in-person workshops. Coaches who have already taken the Level 1 Technical in the old NCCP system may check the box stating they have done so and the \$37.45 fee will be waived.

Reimbursement

The LMBA reimburses coaches at all levels for the registration fee(s) associated with obtaining the coaching certification required to coach in the upcoming season. Once you have obtained the required certification, please provide proof of the certification along with the registration fee receipt(s) to your appropriate LMBA Coach and Player Development Director and you will be reimbursed by the LMBA.

Coaching Requirements Due Date: May 8th

Rally Cap

- 1. All Coaches must be registered in the NCCP system and meet the following requirements:
 - a) Complete an online course called, Respect in Sport Activity Leader. You can access the course by clicking <u>HERE</u>. Some of you might have this already from coaching in other sports (eg. hockey);
 - b) Complete the LMBA Coaches Code of Conduct; it can be accessed by clicking <u>HERE</u>;
 - c) Take NCCP Coach Initiation in Sport Online Module and choose the Coach Initiation in Baseball (Rally Cap) online module;
 - d) A **Criminal Record Check**, even though Rally Cap level is not considered a drop off program.
- 2. Please provide a copies of your required accreditation to the <u>Rally Cap Division Director</u> by May 8th.

<u>9U - Rookie</u>

- 1. All Coaches must be registered in the NCCP system and meet the following requirements:
 - e) Complete an online course called, **Respect in Sport Activity Leader**. You can access the course by clicking <u>HERE</u>. Some of you might have this already from coaching in other sports (eg. hockey);
 - f) Complete the LMBA Coaches Code of Conduct; it can be accessed by clicking <u>HERE</u>;
 - g) Take NCCP Coach Initiation in Sport Online Module <u>HERE</u> and choose the Coach Initiation in Baseball (Fundamentals) online module <u>HERE</u>. To register for the course, please click <u>HERE</u>;
 - h) A criminal record check, even though 9U level is not considered a drop off program.
- 2. <u>Head Coaches</u> to also take the Initiation Coaches Clinic (4 hours). Further information about this clinic can be found <u>HERE</u>. An overview of the Initiation Coach certification can be found <u>HERE</u>. To register for the course, you will need to register for the <u>Initiation Online Module</u> which will then allow you to register for <u>Initiation Coaches Clinic</u>. The online module must be completed before attending an Initiation Coaches Clinic. If you have already completed the Initiation Online Module, please login <u>Here</u> to register in the Initiation Coaches Clinic. The LMBA has historically hosted an Initiation Coaches Clinic in Lacombe at the end of April / start of May. - 3. There will be a 9U coaches (Head and Assistant) meeting prior to the season starting. All 9U coaches will be notified of this meeting when a date, time and location is determined. This meeting will give you the opportunity to meet fellow coaches, review the 9U package including the 1st weeks practice plans and obtain your team's equipment, roster, t-shirts and hats.
- 4. Please provide a copies of your required accreditation to the <u>9U Division Director</u> by May 8th.

11U (Mosquito), 13U (Pee Wee), 15U (Bantam) and 18U (Midget)

- 1. All Coaches must be registered in the NCCP system and meet the following requirements:
 - Complete an online course called, Respect in Sport Activity Leader. You can access the course by clicking <u>HERE</u>. Some of you might have this already from coaching in other sports (eg. hockey);
 - j) Complete the LMBA Coaches Code of Conduct; it can be accessed by clicking HERE;
 - k) Take NCCP Coach Initiation in Sport Online Module <u>HERE</u> and choose the Coach Initiation in Baseball (Fundamentals);
 - I) A criminal record check, If you live in the City of Lacombe you can obtain this from the City of Lacombe detachment. If you live outside of Lacombe, including Lacombe County, you will need to obtain this from a local (Ponoka, Blackfalds) RCMP detachment. The CRC / VSC letter that the police detachment requires can be accessed on the LMBA website under the Coaches tab. A CRC / VSC is required every 3 years (eg. if submitted to LMBA for the 2019 season a new CRC / VSC will be required in 2022). For the years between CRC / VSC submissions, coaches will be required to sign and submit a CRC / VSC Declaration Form which can be accessed on the LMBA website under the Coaches tab.

2. At the <u>Community A level</u>, the LMBA requires <u>Head Coaches</u> to also take the Initiation Coaches Clinic (4 hours). Further information about this clinic can be found <u>HERE</u>. An overview of the Initiation Coach certification can be found <u>HERE</u>. To register for the course, you will need to register for the <u>Initiation Online Module</u> which will then allow you to register for <u>Initiation Coaches</u> Clinic. The online module must be completed before attending an Initiation Coaches Clinic. Please provide a copy of your Respect in Sport Activity Leader certificate, LMBA Coaches Code of Conduct, CRC / VSC, for Community A level proof of completion of the Initiation Online Module (Head and Assistant Coaches) and Initiation Coaches Clinic (Head Coaches) and registration receipt(s) to your appropriate Division Director by May 8th. Meeting the Competitive AA certification requirements is tracked by Baseball Alberta once the initial rosters have been submitted.
