Welcome and Introductions by Shannon Bruns - LMBA President. She stated that she is very excited about the growth in LMBA!

- 4) 2023 Season Highlights and 2024 Season Initiatives
 - 2023 season highlights provided in previous presentation.

2024 Initiatives:

- 11U development program practice format
- Policy updates due to growing association
- Upcoming Rust Busters Sessions-Registration will be capped for these based on facility capacity. Purpose of these sessions is to "dust off" and have fun.
- Skills sessions follow the evaluation format. Open to AA registered players. No evaluators present. These sessions are a chance to run through the evaluation skills prior to try-outs.
- Skill sessions will also be offered to A level players later on in the winter.
- For insurance purposes players must be registered. No additional costs for these sessions.
- Changes to the policy wording for the competitive try-outs. Revised policies will be sent out once 2024 executive meets.
- Akemi Matthie provided words of appreciation for LMBA coaches and encouraged those interested in coaching to take on a coaching role.

- Umpire registration not live yet.
- 6) 2023 Final Budget and 2024 Proposed Budget presented by Jeff Kluthe LMBA Treasurer
 - Budget based on same numbers as 2023.
 - Registration fees staying the same for each age division.
 - Introduction of a separate registration fee for Community A players continuing their season to play in the provincial championship tournament.
 - 2023 surplus of \$4406.80
 - Acknowledgement to the LMBA sponsors.
 - Looking to break even for 2024.
 - Credit Card processing fee changes with Spordle. Administration expenses lowered as a result of Spordle.
 - Repairs/Field maintenance category for 2024 will include the purchase of equipment lock boxes at the U11, U13, U15 and U18 diamonds. These will house the hammers, pegs, base plugs, etc. The hope is that these locked boxes will help reduce the theft of items that occurs from the dugouts.

Mike Berdan made a motion to approve the 2024 Budget as presented. Kim Willington seconded. All in favour.

7) Society Act and Audit Delegation

Brief explanation provided of the Societies Act audit process.

Alison Stangeland nominated Mike Berdan and Pam Oickle to be the 2024 LMBA auditors. Mark Blatz seconded. All in favour.

- 8) Proposed Bylaw/Policy Revisions and Vote

The proposed bylaw revisions were presented by Melanie Callihoo-LMBA Secretary. All changes were highlighted (red=additions, blue=deletions) and discussed for those in attendance. Opportunity for questions was provided.

Additional Fees

There will be additional expenses with Competitive AA teams that are not included in the player's registration and tryout fees. These will be for umpires, tournament entry fees, exhibition games, game balls, etc. These fees can range from \$100.00-\$400.00 per player depending on the extent of such costs. To minimize these additional fees, most teams will organize a fundraiser(s) or obtain sponsors (all fundraising/sponsorships should be approved through the LMBA Fundraising and Apparel Director).

If a Community A team decides to enter a tournament, play exhibition games or enter A provincials, there will be additional costs. All A teams are required to attend the LMBA Community Tournament held in early June at Michener Park in Lacombe. To minimize these additional fees, most teams will organize a fundraiser(s) or obtain sponsors (all fundraising/sponsorships should be approved through the LMBA Fundraising and Apparel Director).

Community A Teams

The Community A Program in LMBA is a development program aimed to ensure players develop skills and learn the fundamentals of baseball at an age appropriate level.

- ★ The Rally Cap (7U) division plays in a house league and there is no travel outside of Lacombe. Season runs from May 1- June 25 on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- ★ The Rookie (9U) division plays in a house league with no travel scheduled outside of Lacombe. Some teams may choose to play games with nearby communities (Bentley, Blackfalds, etc). Rookie (9U) does host a one day mini tournament early June. This tournament is now on the same weekend as the Community A Tournament and is held at Michener Park. Season runs from May 1- June 25 on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- ★ 11U-18U teams are usually determined around the middle of April. Evaluations will take place if there are enough players to form more than 1 team to divide players up and create equal teams. Community teams play in the Central Alberta Baseball League (CABL). Home games will be at Michener Park and away games are usually within a 45 minute drive. The schedule is done by Baseball Alberta and usually provided mid-end April. At the community level, there are no league games on weekends (teams may choose to enter tournaments). Teams can expect 1-2 practices per week for the remainder of April depending on weather and indoor facility availability. The CABL season usually includes 2 games per week from May 1- June 25. Teams may choose to add practices depending on diamond availability and may choose to enter the Provincial Tournament (which will include games into July and possibly hosting games on a weekend). All A teams are required to play in the Lacombe Community Tournament (May 31-June 2) and the CABL Year End Finals (June 22-23). Competitive AA Teams

Competitive teams are usually determined by the middle of March. If there are enough players registered, there will be a tryout process starting after the registration deadline. There may be 1 or more competitive AA teams per division. Players that do not make a AA team are encouraged to play for a Community A team. Once the team is determined, practices 2-3 times per week can be expected throughout the season depending on weather and indoor facility availability. The AA league is province wide and utilizes a 3 round seeding/tiering format. Teams can expect to play in a regional format in May, North/South division in June and Provincial Tiering in July. Each round usually includes 2 weekends per month and 2-4 games per weekend. Practices and exhibition games would take place during the week (practices are usually Tuesdays and Thursdays). Home games and practices take place at Michener Park on the west end of Lacombe, just off Highway 12. Teams may choose to enter tournaments (outside of the tiering weekends).
