Head Coach Honorarium

Central Alberta Selects provides an honorarium of \$8,500 for the Head Coach role for the 2026–2027 season for U13AA, U15AA, U18AA. U11AA Head Coach receives \$4,500.

Role Overview

Head Coaches are responsible for:

- Acting as the team spokesperson.
- Creating a safe and supportive environment for players and assistant coaches.
- Leading on-ice and off-ice development, team culture, and community involvement.
- Attending spring ID skates, tryouts, exhibition games, and evaluations (as applicable).
- Collaborating with the division director on roster and staff selections.
- Preparing seasonal development, communication, and team expectation plans.
- Leading practices, game-day coaching, and video review sessions.
- Communicating with CAS leadership throughout the season.
- Abiding by all Lacombe Minor Hockey and Central Alberta Selects governance guidelines.

Coach Qualifications

- All coaches must complete a coaching application each season.
- Coaches may be required to complete additional Hockey Alberta courses—these are outlined in the coaching requirements documents on the Lacombe Minor Hockey and Hockey Alberta website.
- CRC/VSC must be submitted prior to being rostered as a coach and is valid for three years, with annual acknowledgements if applicable.
