Michael called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm.

1. WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES Michael welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending. Gord McLennan moved that the minutes from the last meeting be approved as presented. Tom Fisher seconded. Carried.

#### 2. PRESIDENT'S REPORT – Michael Kartusch

- **Executive Restructuring** Michael and his family will be moving to Red Deer. He has agreed to stay on in his position until the General Meeting in October. The plan is for Troy to step into the position of President and Michael to assume the position of Past President. Michael will be working with Troy. Sherri asked if an election would be called for Vice President. Discussion followed. In question was Michael's ability to stay on the executive even though his kids will not be members of LMH. Discussion tabled until General meeting.
- **Concession** Carol would like to come back to her position as Head Supervisor. The issue of no one to run the concession has been very stressful and it is a relief to have Carol back. LMH would like to keep her around long term and some members felt an increase in pay was a good idea. Discussion on wages, concession price increases, meals for student workers.

Sherri Straub moved that LMH increase the Supervisor wage by \$2 more /hour. The Assistant supervisor wage will start at \$11/hour with a 90 day probation period and will be re-evaluated at the December meeting. Students wage will be \$8.50/hour already including the minimum wage and parent wage will be \$8/hour. Parents are able to work unlimited hours in the concession. Lisa Otto seconded the motion. Discussion. 0 opposed Carried.

The radio station, Sunny 94, has been a good outlet for LMH to get information out.

# 3. COMMITTEE REPORTS

<u>TREASURER</u> – Sherri Straub Everything is good. We have a list of people who have not paid or do not have their pledge forms signed. Players will not be allowed on the ice until all fees are paid and all forms signed. Directors need these lists so these players can be tracked down and things taken care of.

<u>REGISTRAR</u> – Lin Luymes Lin said everything is going good. The big job now is to get contact names out to the directors. Player numbers so far are:

<u>EQUIPMENT MANAGER</u> – Kevin Frank The locks have been changed on the main door of the equipment room. New pinneys are needed as some were not returned last season. <u>SPONSORSHIP</u> – Shawn Leggett He needs a list of sponsor contacts. Also needing info on the outdoor rink. Other sponsorship ideas were discussed.

Michael met with representatives of RAMP Revenue Partnerships. They are a marketing and sponsorship company wanting to work with Minor Sports Associations. They will be doing all the leg work of approaching businesses to put ads on the Web. There are no up-front cost to LMH. LMH will get 30% of fees from them. Their goal is to get 100 local businesses to sign on for a \$15000 return to LMH. They are already working with us and LMH should receive a cheque for \$3000-5000 at the end of September. Several other associations are signed on with them. They include Innisfail, Olds and Red Deer. Discussion followed.

An application was put in to do the 50/50s at an Oilers game. We have not heard back from them yet.

### CONCESSION POSITION OPEN

<u>GAME AND CONDUCT</u> – Chad Kanngeisser Chad will work on getting a manual for Game and Conduct Guidelines. There has been no info in the past for people to lookup. <u>REFEREE IN CHIEF</u> – Rick Plante absent Michael will talk with him about advertising and recruitment of refs.

<u>ICE CONVENER</u> – Tom Fisher Tom is negotiating with Figure Skating right now for some better tryout ice times. We have received a lot of later ice slots. Lots of 10-11pm. We are losing 4 hours a week in Blackfalds. LMH had 76 hours of unused ice last season. Some was due to scheduling glitches at North Central. If ice is not found elsewhere it will be lacking for minor hockey.

- Mick is to talk to Clive to see if ice is available there.
- Someone questioned ice in Bentley. Mick said Deb Northcott was to set up a meeting with Bentley to find out their intentions on having minor hockey teams there. There is no update yet.
- Lincoln is the boundary line between Lacombe and Bentley. Some kids on the Bentley side have been playing in Lacombe. They would have to return to Bentley, if Bentley is wanting to re-establish their association. Some people would be upset. Discussion on boundaries, imports and provincials.
- More discussion on joining with other associations to build stronger teams. This would take more than a few years.

<u>TOURNAMENT CHAIR</u> – Deb Salmon She just needs tournament dates and costs from Tom. Will get sanctions in. This year is the Bantams turn to host a tournament. They alternate from year to year with Female. No teams in LMH will be hosting Provincials this year. There is not enough ice as Ringette is hosting 2 new tournaments. <u>FUNDRAISING</u> - Lin Luymes Mick reported that it is just a matter of getting forms in for the cash lottery.
