1. WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF PAST MEETING MINUTES

2. PRESIDENT'S REPORT – Troy Rider

- Awards Night This has been scheduled for April 8th at 7:30 in the gymnasium at the Lacombe Junior High School. Plans are finalized and all award recipient names are all in and trophies are being engraved. This is for all teams Atom to Midget. Please be sure all teams are in attendance for this evening.
- Rebels Game LMHA will once again be hosting the Red Deer Rebels for a fundraising game. The night is Friday, September 12th. A small planning group is needed. The first planning meeting will be mid-July.
- Front ice status Troy has talked to the town. They have hired an engineering firm to investigate problems caused by permafrost. The ice is to remain out until the long weekend in September. The hockey camp has been cancelled. Calvin is to keep Troy up to date on any changes and all information. Both rinks should be up and running for tryouts mid to late September. Bantam and Midget have no preseason and start with games right off
- ➤ <u>LA Summer Hockey Camp</u> Without Lacombe ice the camp has been moved to the Collicutt Center. All information will be on a link on the Website.

- Online Coach Evaluation This has been up and running for about two weeks. We have received quite a few in already. This is a good tool for helping with coach selection.
- <u>Team Pictures</u> Pictures are all done and ready for pickup at Jodi's house. LMHA is looking to get out of handling the organization of team photographs. A volunteer is wanted to take on the job of organizing this. Discussion followed on picture quality, timelines, finding photographers.
 <u>Cash Lottery</u> All lottery tickets were sold and draws were done. Once again a successful fundraiser. This brings in about \$12000 to the association. This has a direct impact on registration fees as it keeps them down. This is a proven fundraiser and if LMHA is going away from this, a new option is needed for raising substantial funds. Discussion followed on other fundraising options. Sherri and Lin talked briefly on Sobeys Grocery Cards. This could easily bring in\$25000. Can look at start up for next season.
