Troy called the meeting to order at 7:08 pm.

- 1. WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES Troy welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming. As there was no minutes ready, Susan read from her notes for a recap of highlights from the past meeting. Kevin Frank moved to accept the minutes from the past meeting as presented. Gord McLennan seconded the motion. Carried.
- 2. PRESIDENT'S REPORT Troy Rider

**Rebels Game** Troy reported that the Rebels Game, held on September 12<sup>th</sup>, was once again a success.

- o At last numbers we made \$4500 cash, about the same as last year.
- The tailgate party was good. A few improvements could be made, more promo, more people to work it would be good.
- The Rebels say we are the best run preseason game around and they would like to return again next season. Thanks were given to all who helped make the evening a success.

**Vacant LMHA Operating Committee Positions** All vacant positions were filled shortly after the General Meeting.

**Compensation for positions** This has been discussed before at several meetings as of late.

 Many other associations are compensating their referee assigners and ice conveners. Their busy jobs start in August and don't quit until April.

- A subcommittee has been formed to look into the possible hiring of a Paid General Manager to take on these positions. Until then it was felt that LMHA could compensate these people in some manner.
- Other associations are using one or two systems:
   <u>Honorarium</u> LMHA could give out gift cards, grocery cards, coupons etc.

   <u>Expense claims</u> LMHA would pay for gas, mileage, phone bills etc.
   whatever they might want to submit a receipt for.
- Troy has talked with several associations and Hockey Alberta and this is what a lot are doing. Gord said compensation varied from \$2 a game up to \$500 a month. In Lacombe 250 games were scheduled for Peewee and up. 140 games for Atom and lower. This does not include exhibition or playoff games.

Discussion followed. Troy said \$3600 was put into the budget this season in case LMHA wanted to go this route. Fair compensation might be:

\$250 a month for Lower Assigner for 5 months

\$400 a month for Upper Assigner for 6 months

\$400 a month for Ice Convener for 6 months.

- The association would be over budget going with these numbers. The equipment budget is usually under budget and some could be shuffled over from here to even things out.
- Stettler and Rocky compensate their positions up to \$700 a month.
   Discussion followed on potential compensation.

Kevin Frank moved that Lacombe Minor Hockey Association compensate with an honorarium consisting of: \$250 a month for Lower Referee Assigner, \$400 a month for Upper Referee Assigner and \$400 a month for Ice Convener. These numbers to be re-evaluated at any time. Mike Kozak seconded the motion.

0 opposed 5 abstained Carried.

Abstainers were Tom, Rick, Gord, Denny and Susan.

**Team Play in Hobbema** There was unease with all the violence of late happening in Hobbema. There are safety concerns for our players playing there. Troy contacted Hockey Alberta with concerns for our players. Troy received a letter back. Some key points from the letter were:

- No games will be played late at night.
- o All violence was gang related.
- o There are no gang members playing on Hobbema MH teams.
- There is a 10pm curfew for anyone under 17.
- RCMP will patrol the arenas.
- Security cameras will be installed in the arena.

They assure us that everything possible is being done to keep all players safe.

**Team Pictures** Coordinators are in place. LMH has deadlines in place to get sponsor photos out in a timely manner.

- An Edmonton photographer has been found. They only need 2 weeks for completion of all photos. There are no details on cost yet.
- Sponsor pictures should be back and out Nov 15. Team and Individual pictures should be back by Dec 1.
- o They only do on-ice shots. Probably need about 20 hours total to take all.
- All players may not want an individual picture but <u>every team must have one</u> team sponsor picture taken with all players included.
